Gospel of John

The Easter story is basically a story of where God stands and that stand is clear in the resurrection. He raises up Jesus who told us to turn the other cheek. To go the extra mile, if someone asks for your shirt, give them your coat. He told us one should go first and be reconciled with your brother or sister. Then come and offer your gifts at the altar.

He told us do not return evil for evil but cry out with Him on the cross. "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do." He said feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty and always remember it profits you nothing to gain the whole world then lose your soul. This Jesus' way of life the Father raises up.

In other words, Easter is beyond its tremendous mystery; is a statement. A divine statement of divine values. I do not preach about Easter bunnies and butterflies. They are nice and safe, more comfortable, but the truth is that Easter Christianity is about deeper stuff. It is about life and death, right and wrong.

The fact is, the day Jesus entered Jerusalem from the east on a donkey and Pilate from the west on a war-horse, that was the day you and I were confronted with the choice. Which entrance shall we take? Which procession shall we follow? Easter is the day God announced His choice. By raising His Son from the dead and all that He stood for. Easter is the day God announced His choice, what is left is yours.

Seeing Your Life Through the Gospel

It is the "first day of the week." Mary Magdalene is the first witness of an event which marks not just the beginning of a new week but the transformation of human history. But "it is still dark" and she does not yet understand what has happened. I ponder the mystery.

Wherever we share compassion, justice, reconciliation, faith, and encourage each other to be people of hope, we are people of the resurrection and ministers of the resurrection. Jesus is raised from death each time we live his way of life. We do this in our various ways of showing care and concern for the lives and troubles of others. Easter prayer can be an asking in prayer to be ministers of the resurrection, as we discern how best to serve the rise Lord.

The tomb was empty and, for the faithful ones, this was a sign of new life. Some would remember Jesus saying he would rise from death. Others would feel down, cheated or just lost. It is the same with ourselves: the tough times of life can bring us close to God, or distance us; suffering can make us better people, or make us bitter and isolated. We may feel a bit of both at times. The empty tomb is the message that nothing is final in this life, not even death. God's love is stronger than any human power, violence or cruelty. Love conquers all.



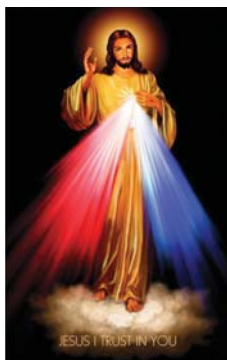

How do you, as a young adult, know when you are following God's plan, and when you are straying from it?

It's very easy to claim that you're following God's plan. You can say it as many times as you want, but that doesn't mean you actually are. Saying it is a lot different than actually living it. 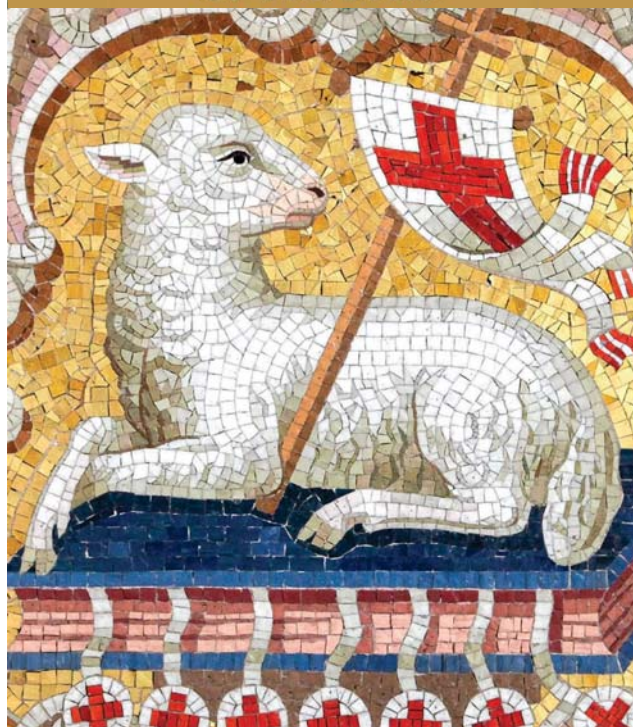

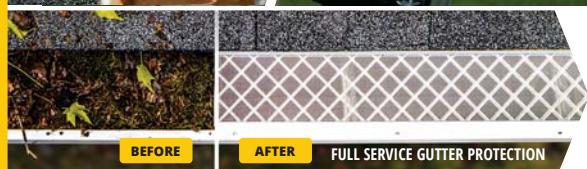
