Believing that our families are best served when as much information as possible is available when needed, we are providing you with the attached price list for the services, facilities and other items you may purchase. Since there is a broad range of needs and preferences among different families, there are some items listed that will not apply to your arrangements. All funeral and cremation options carry a charge for the services of the Funeral Director and Staff including compliance with governmental regulations and overhead. Some other items may be necessary for the type of funeral/cremation services you arrange or may be required because of state regulations. Cash advance items that you select are provided by third party businesses but are billed through us. Your Funeral Director will provide you with specific information about these cash advance items: obituary/photo charges, certified death certificates, flowers, open / close grave charges, etc. Most of these items contain a description to help you to determine whether you should include it in your arrangement. At the end of your discussion with the Funeral Director, you will be provided with a cost statement itemizing and totaling the various items you selected, so that you will know the total cost of the service arrangements.

Our normal office hours are 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday – Friday and 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Saturday. The funeral home is open at other times by appointment or when needed to accommodate arrangement conferences, visitations and/or services. A licensed funeral director is available by phone 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We do not allow overnight visitation due to safety regulations and the high cost of liability insurance. We try to provide the best services possible and to offer them at reasonable prices. We appreciate the opportunity to be of service to you and your family. Let us help you with preplanning any type of service you need.

GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of May 1, 2026 and are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

A. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF AND OVERHEAD-----\$3,395.00

This fee for our basic services of funeral director and staff and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains. This fee includes the following:

1. Professional services of the funeral director and staff, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial death call.
2. The funeral director will help you with your arrangement conference to finalize wishes and coordination of service details with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.
3. Office administrative services for completing documents associated with the funeral and/or cremation. This includes helping to prepare the obituary notice, all internal record keeping, etc.
4. Regulatory compliance / governmental requirements with federal trade commission (FTC), occupational safety and health administration (OSHA), worker's compensation, auto and liability insurance, federal disability act, professional licensing, maintenance of funeral home & equipment, and city / county property taxes.

B. FORWARDING OF DECEASED TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME-----\$3,160.00

This charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff and overhead, transfer of deceased to funeral home, embalming and other preparation, funeral vehicle to the Nashville or Atlanta airport, and shipping container. This does not include autopsy cases, major restoration, shipping charges, merchandise, sales tax on merchandise, visitation, services or additional charges for special circumstances.

C. RECEIVING OF DECEASED FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME-----\$3,965.00

This includes basic services of funeral director and staff and overhead, funeral vehicle to the Nashville or Atlanta airport, and hearse to cemetery. This does not include use of full facility charges, visitations, ceremonies in our chapel, merchandise selected, shipping charges or additional charges for special circumstances.

D. EMBALMING, PREPARATIONS OF THE DECEASED:

Embalming, Sanitary Care and Preservation.....\$895.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

However, if funeral services are delayed longer than 48 hours, embalming may be required due to health and safety reasons. In certain cases, conditions may not allow for viewing or dressing, and viewing will be determined on an hour-by-hour basis.
