- We expect some interpretation and sharing, following participation in this experience such
  as making a report to the presbytery and/or to the Cultivation and Empowerment Committee
  (CEC), staffing a table and sharing a display at a presbytery meeting, or writing an article for
  THIS WEEK.
- We expect that any funds not directly used for the project or trip will be returned.

## OTHER HELPFUL INFORMATION:

- Every request will be prayerfully considered.
- Requests of more than \$5,000 will require two approvals by the committee.
- Ordinarily, we <u>no longer</u> provide financial support for building maintenance, operating budget support, or "aid to field" (salary support for pastoral leadership).
- Ordinarily, we extend priority to those who have not previously received a grant, scholarship, or other financial assistance, thus, subsequent requests by any congregation will be considered at 50% of the full amount requested.

The mission of the Presbytery of New Harmony is to strengthen, nurture, and sustain its congregations and ministers, and to participate in the wider mission of the church through its higher councils.
