Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What does it cost? Members \$50.00 Program Participants \$100.00
- 2. What is the maximum number of children in a session?
- 12 (2-year-olds), 12 (3-year-olds) and 12 (4-year-olds)
- 3. What toys/activities are there to do? We have age appropriate educational toys and activities that will help your child develop. While you're at the Y our Play and Learn Coaches (P & L Coaches) will be there to guide you so you can learn with your child through PLAY!
- 4. Do we have to stay for the whole session? No, most families find what's the right amount of time for their little one.
- 5. Can I leave my child? No, caregivers are responsible for supervising and interacting with your child. If a family is looking for child watch, we offer services in our Kids Zone Room from 8:00am-11:00am.
- 6. Will I receive items to help me work with my child at home? Yes, we will have parenting tools to help you work with your child at home.
- 7. Can I bring my older child/children? Together We Play & Learn sessions are designed for young children 2 to 4 years. We are not designed to include children 5 years and older in the play & learn sessions.
- 8. How will you keep the play stations clean? Sanitizing stations will be available. We ask that everyone wash their hands and sanitize upon entering and throughout their play session.
