

Te Hinemanu Ruakā Te Ūpokoiri Charitable Trust

There are two types of grants provided by the Te Hinemanu Ruakā Te Ūpokoiri Charitable Trust.

The first is specifically for students of Te Wānanga o Raukawa who are also school leavers. The following pertains to this group:

Purpose

This scholarship seeks to support Māori language study at Te Wānanga o Raukawa, specifically,

- a. The learning and teaching of the Māori language
- b. The research and advancement of the Māori language
- c. The learning and teaching of Māori history
- d. The research and advancement of Māori history.

Who can apply

Any Māori school leaver or wharekura student intending to study at Te Wānanga o Raukawa can apply. Preference will be given to Māori people who include as a significant part of their tertiary course:

- a. Te reo Māori, and/or
- b. as described above in Purpose a-d. Closing date 31 October of the previous year that study is to be undertaken.

How to apply

Applicants are to write an essay of 500-700 words about themselves. It should include: some background information of themselves:

- a. their educational history
- b. their experience in things Māori
- c. their educational aspirations for themselves, their whānau, hapū and iwi
- d. how they will contribute to te reo Māori and to their whānau, hapū and iwi.

Applicants should also provide their contact details.

The second type is for descendants of Te Hinemanu, Rūakā or Te Upokoiri who are enrolled in tertiary study anywhere and include learning te reo Māori and iwi history in their studies.

Their applications should be supported by:

- Letter of application from the students setting out their area of study and how they intend to apply that study
- Confirmation of the student's enrolment in the appropriate course
- Confirmation of the students's ancestry to the above hapū
- Recommendation from the hapū trustees for the grant to be approved.
