

Open Category The Open category race at 9:50 am is, by definition, open to all racers. However, it is intended for women, transgender women and non-binary athletes who wish to race together.

USAC Registration & Logistics

The Elmhurst Cycling Classic is held under USA Cycling permit # 2026-15284. The USA Cycling rules and scale of penalties apply. USA Cycling officials will be responsible for all start/finishes, rulings, and determining end results and scoring.

Riders may only race in the category as stated on their USA Cycling license. The Standard USA Cycling Event Waiver must be signed by all riders. Minors must also have a parent or legal guardian sign the waiver.

Race-day registration closes 30 minutes prior to the start of each race. A \$10 fee is added to registrations after online pre-registration has closed. There will be no race refunds. Riders may not transfer their entry to another rider.

Bib numbers are to be picked up at Registration prior to 30 minutes before the start of your race. Registration is located behind the stage on the Elmhurst University side of the course.

PIN BIB NUMBERS ON THE RIGHT SIDE. Bib numbers are to be placed on the body so they can be read by our photo finish camera. Numbers are not to be obscured by hair, vests, or other coverings. **Do not cut or alter bib numbers.**

Bib Position – Not on your back. Not upside down. Not cut. Not crumpled. Not left side.

Primes will be regularly awarded during each race, as listed in the Prize tables. Primes are to be collected immediately after each race. Riders do not need to complete the race to claim primes. Primes may be in cash or product.

Free Laps may be granted for “recognized” mishaps, according to USA Cycling Regulations. Free laps end at the number of laps determined by the USAC officials.

Neutral Support will be available on a limited basis. **You are encouraged to bring your own wheels for “wheels in/wheels out.”** Your wheels should be tagged with your information. Some spare wheels will be available. Mechanics will be on course to address most mishaps. The USAC Pit Referee will determine eligibility of free laps.

Neutral Support services will be provided by PSIMET, and they will address mechanical issues and flats to the best of their ability. A limited number of wheels will be available for racers. Mechanics will work under the supervision and direction of a USAC referee who will determine free laps and timing. Riders suffering a mishap must make it to the neutral service pit under their own power.

Neutral support is located at a “bump out” on the Wilder Park side of the course, approximately 100 meters before the start/finish line. Riders will stage for reentry on the Elmhurst University side of the course under the direction of a USAC pit official.

Awards - Please claim your awards immediately following each race. Report to the stage and registration area.

Podium Presentations – The top 3 racers in each category should report to the stage immediately after each race. As soon as the officials confirm the results, there will be an on-stage presentation.

Team Tents Location - Tents are to be located north (before) the Start/Finish line. **DO NOT PLACE TEAM TENTS NEXT TO THE SIDEWALK AS IT OBSTRUCTS THE VIEWS OF OFFICIALS AND SPECTATORS AND LIMITS PEDESTRIAN FLOW.** You will be asked to move your tent away from sidewalks. DO NOT PUT TEAM TENTS IN THE EXPO AREA. Ask a member of the race committee for information if you have questions. No team tents within 200 meters of the Start/Finish line.

Consent for Photography / Videography



Weekend Omnium – Elmhurst Cycling Classic & The Cobb Park Criterium

The Elmhurst Cycling Classic is part of a 2-day omnium with the Cobb Park Criterium on June 7, 2026 in Kankakee, IL. Registration for both events is done separately through BikeReg. Scoring for the omnium will be combined and finalized June 7th in Kankakee.

Race schedules are different Saturday and Sunday to accommodate travel. Please note the omnium races below, and choose your races accordingly. Riders need to participate in both races to be eligible for Omnium prizes and points. Protests concerning the Omnium placings are to be directed to the Omnium Judge.

Scoring: Omnium points will be awarded according to the following table. Rankings are determined in order of the sum of the points earned at the end of the series. In the case of a tie in total points, the following tiebreakers will apply until the tie is broken: a) The most first-place finishes or, if still tied the most second-place finishes, etc. b) the highest placing in the last race in which one of the tied riders placed.
