A. FINANCIAL STATUS AND RIDERSHIP: THE CASH POSITION REMAINS STRONG. WE HAVE RECEIVED 77.3% OF THE BUDGETED REVENUE AND DISBURSED 58.1% OF THE BUDGETED EXPENSES. THE "ITA" CARRIED 1081 NEW RIDERS, INCLUDING 833 FROM LAKETOWN AND 95 FROM THE CITY OF FENNVILLE. TOTAL RIDERSHIP FOR MAY WAS 6461!.
