COLLECT

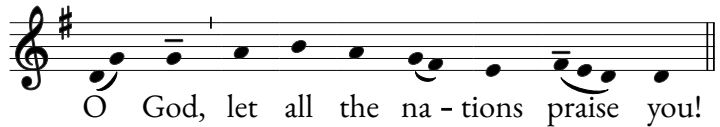

We proclaim your Death, O Lord, / and profess your Resurrection / until you come again.

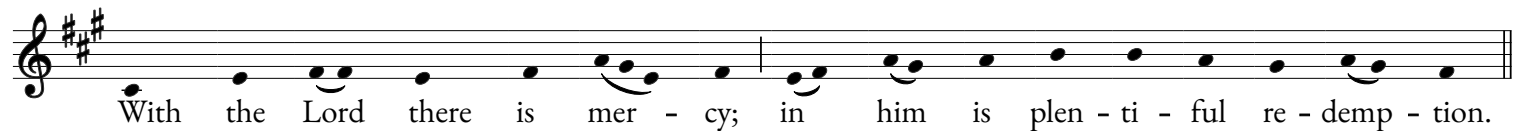
