## A Message from the Chairman & CEO

Dear Friends,

As we review the past year's achievements, it is incredible to consider all the ways that NAPAC Foundation has grown and continues to serve the Nigerian American Community and various other communities since it began in 2013. I would like to express my sincere appreciation for our collective efforts through NAPAC Foundation's four programs. The individual stories associated with every contribution demonstrate that our commitment to empowering and supporting various and multigenerational communities locally and globally continues to have a significant impact.

In 2025, we pursued ambitious objectives to broaden our influence across education, leadership development, food security, healthcare, and social responsibility initiatives. With your steadfast support, we not only achieved these goals but also established a strong foundation for lasting impact.

I am humbled and grateful to share highlights of our year in the following pages. Our standout achievements this year were the **Naija Fest celebrations in Northern and Southern California**, both combined for record breaking attendance (**1800+**), **25 vendors/businesses participation** and additional **4 new sponsors** providing a platform for community engagement. Additionally, our specialized funds, such as the **Nigerian Community Legal Assistance** fund and **the Social Responsibility, Justice and Community Engagement (SRJCE) Program** fund received significant donations that translated directly into life-changing services for people in need including the Eaton fire victims in the City of Altadena. Our annual **Education, Training and Leadership Development (ETLD) Program scholarship awards** for high school graduates **increased by \$2500**.

I am especially appreciative of the wide range of support we received, whether it's a **\$10 donation from an individual** or a **\$10,000 gift from a major donor**, each contribution is vital to our organization. Our data reveals that although California is at the heart of our mission, our reach is expanding throughout the United States and Nigeria.

### Looking Ahead to 2026

During the closing months of the year, our **Year End Fundraiser** proved highly successful, generating nearly **53% of our total annual revenue**. This significant increase in contributions positions us well to continue advancing our essential programs into 2026. As we look forward to the future, our vision for the coming year is clear:

- **Economic Empowerment:** Increasing the reach of our Food Security and Economic Empowerment Program (FSEEP).
- **Enhance Advocacy:** Strengthening our voice and providing a platform for the next generation of Nigerian Americans and other minority groups through our Speak Now program.
- **Expand Impact:** Continuing to bridge the gap between all minority communities in the U.S. and those in need in Nigeria through all our programs.

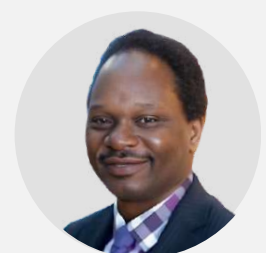
