

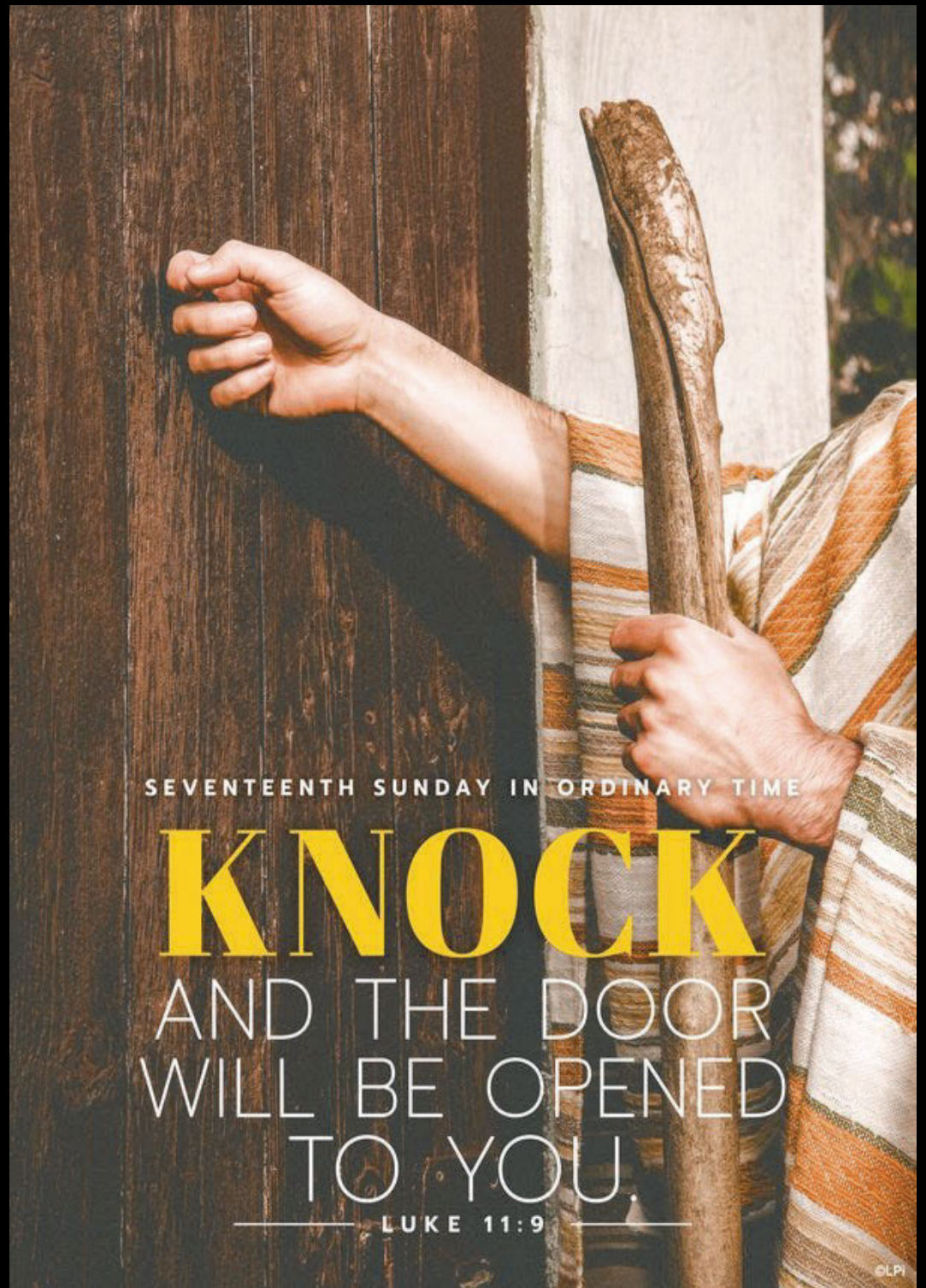

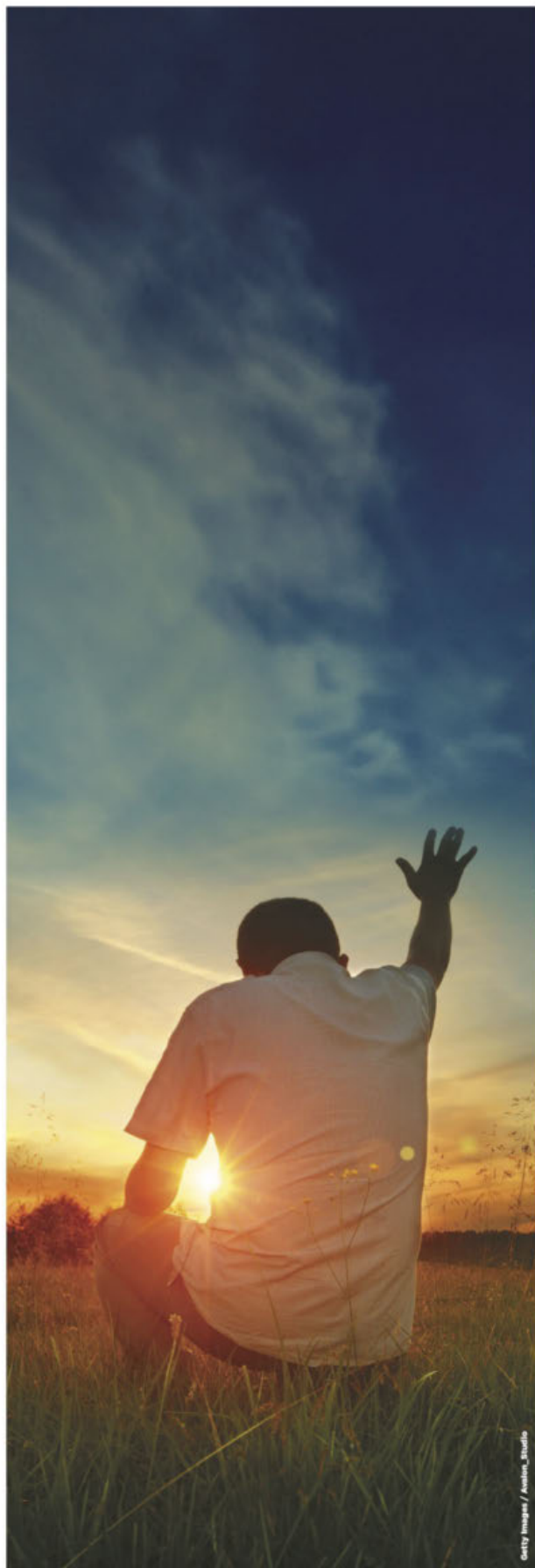

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Sounds lovely, doesn't it? I remember understanding this verse as though God is like a genie in a bottle and prayer is like a delivery service. But when I encountered true hardship, this interpretation was tested. I was seeking, but I couldn't find what I wanted. My request seemed to go unanswered. I was asking, but my hands were empty. I couldn't reconcile this. Did this mean God wasn't telling me the truth? Trusting that couldn't be the case, I pressed in a little harder. In time, and through the grace of God, I realized I'd been reading this verse through selfish eyes. I was understanding this passage to say, "ask for whatever you feel like in the moment, and I'll drop it on your doorstep." But what does Jesus *actually* say? He says that if we ask, he will always give us *the Holy Spirit*. This understanding can change how we pray. The Lord doesn't promise to instantly cure our maladies, or to remove every ounce of pain on this side of the veil. But he does promise to send his Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to be with us through it all. And that is far better than any type of delivery service.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's psalm echoes the Gospel message that the Lord never abandons us. In our response, we unite our voices with the universal Church as we say, "Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me." We encounter hardship on a daily basis. From the tiny irritations that tempt our tempers to flare to the heavy crosses we carry, we are reminded of how much we need God's help. And yet, how often is our response to turn inward and grow weary, discouraged, or angry? Next time we come eye to eye with a challenge, let's try to respond like the psalmist, and cry out to the Advocate. He is very near. *Come Holy Spirit.*

REFLECT

We are reminded in today's readings that the Lord is always near, that he hears us, and that he responds generously. Thank God this is true even when it doesn't seem like it. As we face our daily hardships, let's not forget to ask Jesus for help. Don't forget that he never rations the Spirit, and though he will never force himself on you, he's waiting eagerly to pour his love into your heart. Ask! Seek! Knock! He knows your voice, and he is ready to respond.

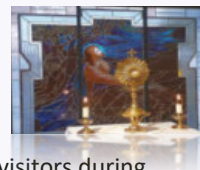

GROW IN HOLINESS

First of the Month Devotions

This week, we celebrate both First Friday (August 1) and First Saturday (August 2) of the month.

Please join us **after the 8:30am Masses** for special devotions:

- **Friday** – Devotion to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**
- **Saturday** – Devotion to the **Immaculate Heart of Mary**

First Friday Devotion – August 2

After the 8:30am Mass, join us in praying the Litany and Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

At the end of the 17th century, Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, asking her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. He promised that those who receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays would receive the grace of final repentance, they would not die without receiving the sacraments.

"My Divine Heart will be your assured refuge at the last moment."

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NINE FIRST FRIDAYS DEVOTION:

Receive Holy Communion on each First Friday (preferably at Mass) with the intention of honoring the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

If you are aware of mortal sin, you must go to Confession before receiving Communion to be in a state of Sanctifying Grace.

CONFESSION TIMES:

- Saturday: 4:00pm – 5:00pm
- Monday – Friday: 6:30pm – 7:00pm

First Friday:

- Morning: 8:00am – 8:30am
- Evening: 6:00pm – 7:00pm (English & Polish)

NOTE:

To receive the promised grace, the Nine First Fridays must be:

- Consecutive
- Made in honor and reparation to the Sacred Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges, and indifferences committed against It.

Let us draw closer to the merciful Heart of Jesus and grow in holiness together.

ADULT CONFIRMATION Fall 2025

The Adult Confirmation Process of the Archdiocese of Chicago is a pre-sacramental program for adults (18 and older) who have already received the Catholic sacrament of Baptism and First Holy Communion and are seeking to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.

Adults who have not received the Catholic sacraments of Baptism and First Holy Communion should contact their local parish to join the OCIA process.

The Adult Confirmation sessions are offered on Zoom in English and Spanish (**Flyer**).

Wspomnienie św. Marty, Marii i Łazarza – 29 lipca

29 lipca Kościół wspomina święte rodzeństwo z Betanii, Martę, Marię i Łazarza, bliskich przyjaciół Jezusa. To w ich domu Jezus często gościł, znajdując odpoczynek, gościnność i miłość.

Marta symbolizuje służbę i troskę o innych, Maria – modlitwę i nasłuchiwanie słowa Bożego, a Łazarz – wiarę w moc zmartwychwstania. Ich życie przypomina nam, jak ważne jest łączenie wiary z codzienną miłością i gościnnością wobec Jezusa i bliźnich.



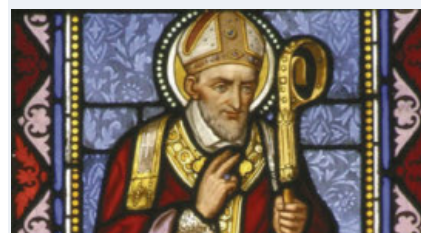
Wspomnienie Św. Ignacego Loyola – 31 lipca

Założyciel Towarzystwa Jezusowego (jezuitów), urodzony w 1491 roku w Hiszpanii. Początkowo żołnierz, po ciężkim zranieniu w bitwie przeszedł duchową przemianę i

poświęcił życie Bogu. Jest autorem znanych Ćwiczeń duchowych, które pomagają w pogłębianiu relacji z Bogiem.

Św. Ignacy uczy, by we wszystkim szukać i znajdować Boga, a jego motto „Ad maiorem Dei gloriam” – *Na większą chwałę Bożą* – inspiruje wiernych do dziś. Zmarł 31 lipca 1556 roku i został kanonizowany w 1622 roku.

Wspomnienie św. Alfonsa Marii Liguoriego – 1 sierpnia



1 sierpnia obchodzimy wspomnienie św. Alfonsa Liguoriego – biskupa, doktora Kościoła i założyciela Zgromadzenia Najświętszego Odkupiciela (redemptorystów). Urodzony w 1696 roku we Włoszech, był utalentowanym

prawnikiem, który porzucił karierę świecką, by służyć Bogu jako kapłan.

Św. Alfons zasłynął jako wybitny kaznodzieja, spowiednik i autor duchowych dzieł, w tym znanego „Teologii moralnej”. Jego nauczanie łączyło głęboką wiarę z miłosierdziem i troską o zbawienie każdego człowieka. Jest także patronem spowiedników i moralistów.
