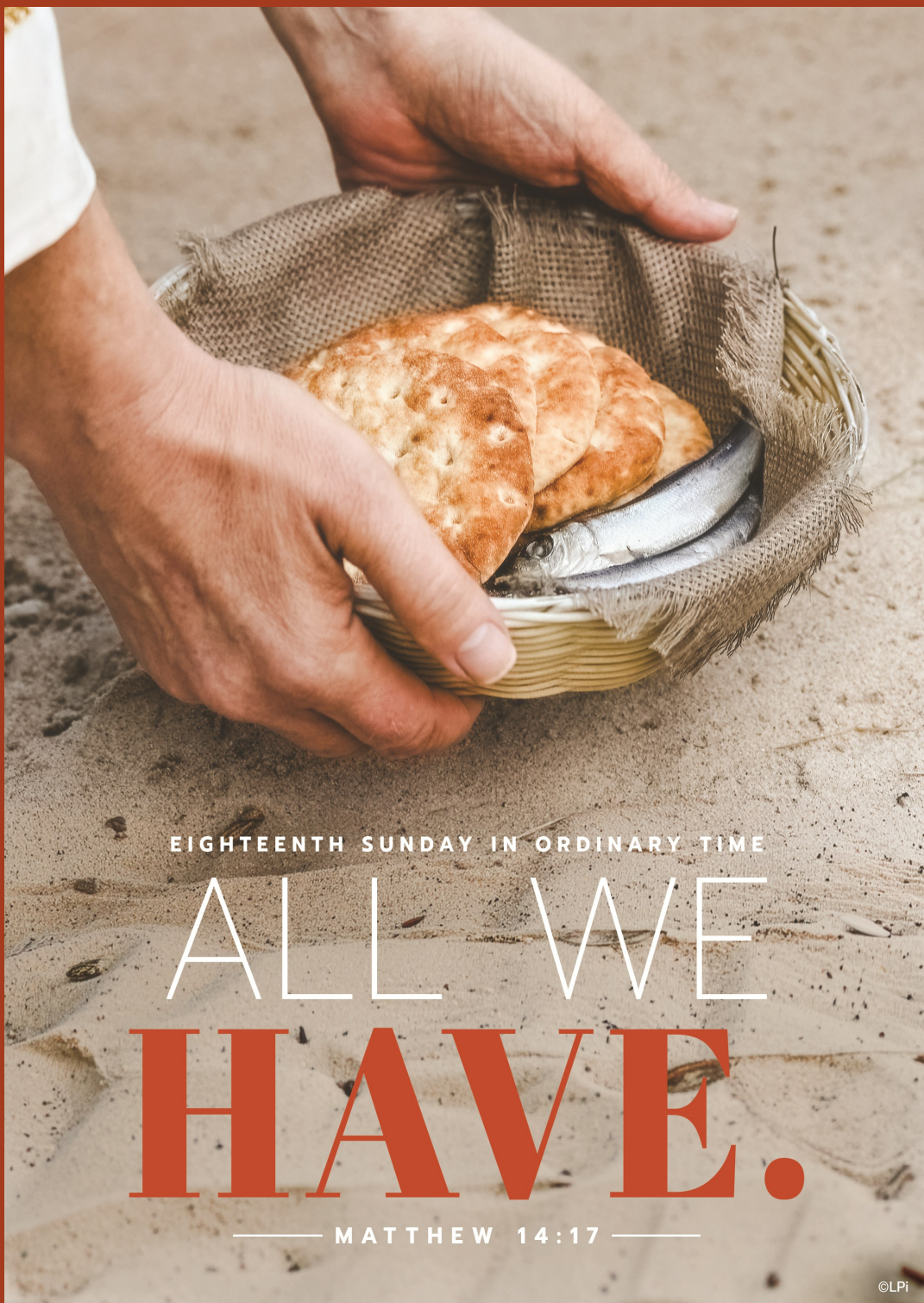

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In one of the best homilies I ever heard on today's Gospel, the homilist pointed out that the Lord had seemingly "over-multiplied" the loaves and fish. The crowds had eaten to the point of satisfaction, and yet there were twelve baskets of leftovers remaining. "Why so many leftovers? Did the Lord not know how to count?" He asked jokingly, of course. But the point the homilist went on to share that day was that with God, there is always abundance. God doesn't simply provide the bare minimum of what we need for *survival*; the Scriptures tell us that he provides "rich fare" that will "satisfy the desire of every living thing." As we reflect on today's readings, let us not question the Lord's ways, but trust in the abundant generosity of God that satisfies all our needs.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Moments in which God provides for our every need strengthen our faith in him. Yet when difficulties come, we know that God never abandons us. Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans speaks about the unshakable confidence Paul has in God's love for us, despite the difficulties (including shipwreck, beatings, and imprisonment) he endured: "What will separate us from the love of Christ? Will anguish, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword?" "No," he says. Nothing "will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus." Take stock of times in your life when God's providence has carried you through difficult times. Consider ways you can share these moments with others as part of your testimony. When our faith rests on a deep awareness of God's faithful love in our lives, we will be able to bear a compelling witness of his goodness to others.

ACCOMPANIMENT

In the Gospel, God shows his loving care by providing for the needs of his people in practical ways. Consider one way you might be able to accompany others going through periods of challenge or trial by providing practical help. This might look like preparing a meal for a new mom in the throes of postpartum, helping with yardwork for a fellow parishioner recovering from surgery, or helping gather classroom supplies for a teacher serving in an impoverished district. In these simple yet concrete ways, we manifest the abundance of God's care and concern for each and every person.

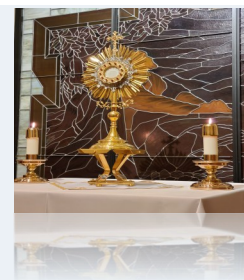

GROW IN HOLINESS

First of the Month Devotions

On 1st Friday (August 6) after 8:30am Mass we pray a Litany and an Act of Consecration to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. At the end of the 17th century, Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alcoque and asked her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. He said to all who receive Holy Communion on 9 First Fridays, of consecutive months, they will receive the grace of final repentance. They will not die without receiving their sacraments. His Divine Heart will make itself the assured refuge at the last moment



Requirements for the Nine First Fridays Devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

- Receive Holy Communion on each First Friday (preferably at Holy Mass) with the intention of honoring Our Lord Jesus Christ's Most Sacred Heart. *Note: If you have knowledge that you are not in a state of Sanctifying Grace (that is, you are knowledgeable of mortal sin(s) on your soul, and thus unable to receive Holy Communion) you will also need to go to Confession prior to receiving your Holy Communion on the First Friday.*

Saturday: 4pm - 5pm

Monday - Friday 6:30pm—7pm

First Friday: 8am—8:30am & 6pm - 7pm (English & Polish)

- The Nine First Fridays must be consecutive.
- The Nine First Fridays must be made in honor of and in reparation to Our Lord's Most Sacred Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges, and indifferences committed against It.

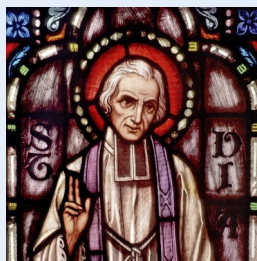
Each Wednesday we pray the **Mother of Perpetual Help Novena**. From Crete to Rome, this devotion has spread to the present day. In the Philippines, the Novena was first recited following World War II. The Holy See granted devotion to the icon, along with prayers to strengthen marriages, heal sickness and help find employment. Because of the prompt and miraculous assistance to those who call upon her, the Mother of Perpetual Help has been loved for over 500 years. **Also, please remember that our chapel is always open!** We are welcome to stop by anytime. THIS WEEK:

MEMORIAL OF ST. JOHN VIANNEY

August 4

On August 4, the Church honors St. John Mary Vianney (1786–1859), the humble parish priest of Ars, France, and the **Patron Saint of Parish Priests**. Although he struggled academically and faced many obstacles on his path to the priesthood, his deep love for God, tireless prayer, and compassionate care for souls made him one of the greatest priests in the history of the Church. St. John Vianney spent countless hours hearing confessions, often up to 16 hours a day, guiding sinners back to God's mercy. His holiness and wisdom drew pilgrims from all over France, earning him the title, *the Curé of Ars*. Pope Pius XI declared him the Patron Saint of Parish Priests in 1929. As we celebrate his memorial, let us pray in a special way for all priests, that they may faithfully proclaim the Gospel, administer the sacraments with love, and lead God's people with the heart of Christ. May St. John Vianney inspire each of us to grow in holiness through prayer, humility, and trust in God's mercy.



FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD – AUGUST 6

On August 6, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. On Mount Tabor, Jesus revealed His divine glory to Peter, James, and John, strengthening their faith before His Passion. The Father's voice proclaimed, *"This is my beloved Son... listen to Him."* As we celebrate this feast, may we renew our commitment to listen to Christ each day and allow His light to transform our hearts, giving us hope and strength to faithfully follow Him.

REFLEKSJE PARAFIAN

Miesięczna refleksja przedstawiciela naszej wspólnoty parafialnej

Drodzy Parafianie,

Czytania z tego weekendu przypominają nam o Bożej hojności i Jego wielkiej miłości. W pierwszym czytaniu, pochodzącym z Księgi Izajasza, słyszymy, jak Pan zaprasza wszystkich spragnionych, by przyszlizli i za darmo przyjęli Jego dary. Nam, rodzicom, wychowawcom i parafianom, przypomina to, że również nasze dzieci łakną miłości, właściwego ukierunkowania, mądrości i wiary.

List św. Pawła do Rzymian zapewnia nas, że nic nie zdoła nas odłączyć od miłości Chrystusa; to niezwykle poczekające przesłanie dla młodych ludzi, którzy mierzą się z różnymi wyzwaniem, budując przyjaźnie i dojrzewają.

Z kolei w Ewangelii według św. Mateusza Jezus karmi tłumy zaledwie pięcioma chlebami i dwiema rybami, pokazując nam, że nawet najskromniejsze dary, złożone w Boże ręce mogą przynieść niezwykle owoce. W naszej szkolnej społeczności każdego dnia jesteśmy świadkami tej prawdy, widząc, jak wyjątkowe dary i talenty uczniów są pielęgnowane i pomnażane dzięki wierze, nauce oraz służbie bliźnim.

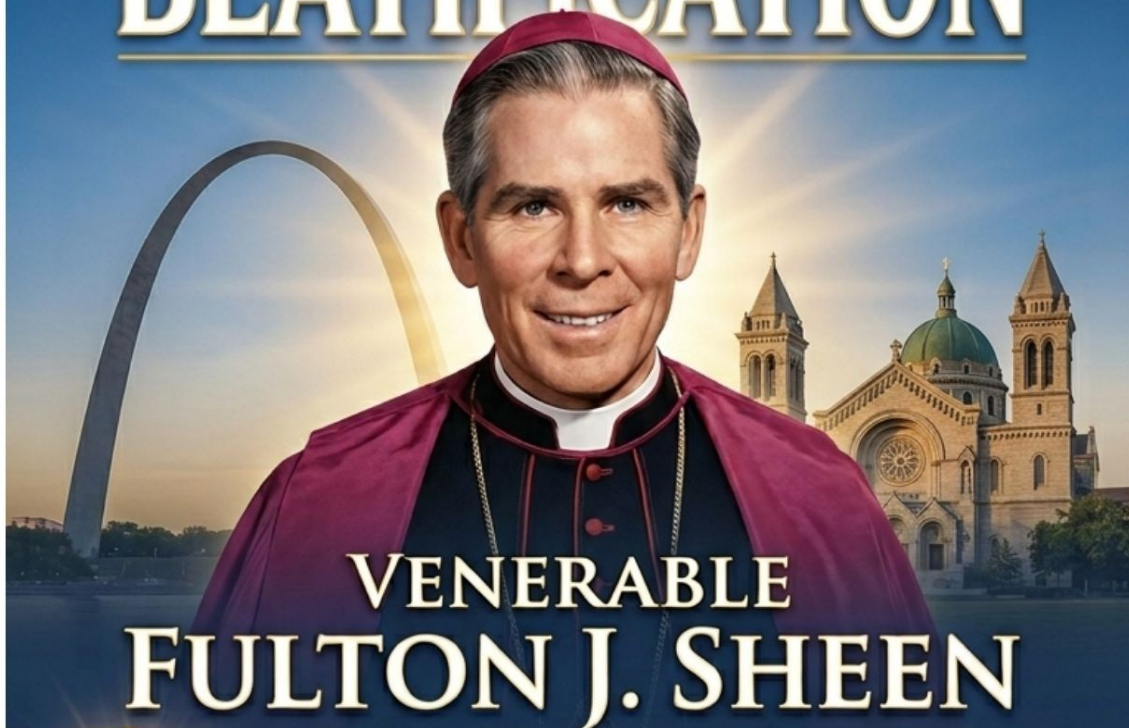
