WHAT IF MY PROVIDER DETERMINES I NEED SPECIALIST CARE?

If the provider determines you need specialist care (ex. cardiologist, dermatologist, urologist, etc.), the provider will make a referral to a specialist office.



COUNSELING-If you are in need of behavioral health services (uninsured or have Medicaid), BHMC can refer you to VTMHI. This telehealth service will cost you \$0 AND you can schedule your appointment from anywhere that has reliable internet or cell phone service.



DENTAL- If you are in need of dental care (uninsured or have Medicaid), BHMC can refer you to Big Walker Dentistry. They are located in the BHMC building and have a low-cost sliding fee schedule. 276-228-4711

HOW DO I KNOW MY RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES?


Please make sure you keep your copy of the "Notice of Privacy Practices (NPP)." You can also request a copy of the "Patient Acknowledgements & Authorizations."
