Smart Goals:

ELA Goal: During the 2025-2026 school year, Moreland Elementary will increase the percentage of kindergarten students scoring proficient on the IRI from 33% in the fall to 70% in the spring (which is a 37% increase) and the number of 1st grade students scoring proficient on the IRI from 54% in the fall to 60% in the spring (which is a 6% increase).

Moreland will continue to screen for and use the MTSS –R process to discuss students who are struggling in the area of literacy. The MTSS-R team will direct the implementation of research-based interventions for students receiving Tier II and Tier III interventions.

Moreland will increase opportunities for parent engagement with the school by working with the PTA to host a free Tailgate Party Night, a Wellness Night, and three parent advisory meetings. Moreland will engage parents of preschool-aged children to increase kindergarten readiness for future students in the community by hosting monthly Play 2 Learn Nights.
