- Applicant must be a residential customer of The Connecticut Light and Power Company and Yankee Gas Services Company, each doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource), or the Connecticut subsidiary of Avangrid Networks, Inc., The United Illuminating Company (UI)
- Windows must be installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026
- Applications must be postmarked by February 27, 2027
- Window replacements must be installed in existing homes—new construction does not qualify
- Windows must be ENERGY STAR certified triple pane with a U-factor ≤ 0.20 if replacing single pane, single pane with storms or double pane windows
- Windows must be ENERGY STAR certified triple pane with a U-factor ≤ 0.21 with grid if replacing single pane, single pane with storms or double pane windows

2026 Residential Rebate Terms and Conditions

Energize ConnecticutSM

Rebate(s) are valid for all active residential customers (Customer) of either The Connecticut Light and Power Company and Yankee Gas Services Company each dba Eversource Energy (Eversource) or the Connecticut subsidiaries of Avangrid Networks, Inc., Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation (CNG), The Southern Connecticut Gas Company (SCG) and The United Illuminating Company (UI), (the Companies). Customer must presently heat or replace heating systems fueled by electric, natural gas, oil, or propane to qualify for a rebate(s). Eligible homes include existing single family and 2–4 unit multifamily structures. Equipment/measure must be installed and comply with all local building codes and relevant safety regulations. Rebate offering is subject to change without prior notice, including rebate availability and incentive levels. **The rebate cannot be combined with any other utility rebate or incentive.** Rebate term limits are equipment/measure specific, please reference the applicable rebate for the allotted term and postmark date. **Rebate amount not to exceed the total cost of the equipment/measure and installation.**

Eligibility

Air and Ground Source Heat Pump Rebate: Customer must replace existing oil, propane, natural gas, or electric baseboard heating systems as the primary heating source to qualify. If an existing boiler or furnace will be left in place, a qualified integrated control must be installed for heating zones where propane, oil, or natural gas will remain in use. Air and ground source heat pumps must be ENERGY STAR[®] certified or listed by the Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI), and listed on the Energize Connecticut Heat Pump Qualified Product List (HPQPL). Integrated controls must also be listed on the HPQPL. Refer to [EnergizeCT.com/HPQPL](https://energizect.com/HPQPL). The rebate is only available to residences that are occupied full time during the winter heating season. The rebate is not applicable to residential new construction projects. Qualifying equipment measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027. Equipment must be installed by a contractor participating in the Energize CT Heat Pump Installer Network (HPIN).

Replacing a heat pump with an existing heat pump, previously unconditioned space, or for cooling only: Equipment must be ENERGY STAR Cold Climate certified or listed by the AHRI, and listed on the HPQPL. Refer to [EnergizeCT.com/HPQPL](https://energizect.com/HPQPL). Equipment must be installed by a contractor participating in the Energize CT HPIN. Qualifying Equipment Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027.

Pool Pump Rebate: Limit of one rebate per residential electric account. Pool pump must be ENERGY STAR certified and at least 0.5 horsepower, new and not leased, rented or refurbished. Booster pumps are not eligible. For a list of qualifying models, visit [EnergizeCT.com/PoolPumps](https://energizect.com/PoolPumps). Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027.

Wi-Fi Thermostat Rebate: Wi-Fi thermostat must be ENERGY STAR certified, limited to three (3) thermostats per customer installation address. Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027.

Under no circumstances will the total incentive for a single Wi-Fi thermostat exceed the offered rebate amount. If the Wi-Fi thermostat already received an instant discount at a participating retailer, through the Companies' online stores or at a distributor location through a licensed installation contractor, the mail-in rebate is not eligible for redemption. For questions on applied rebates, please speak with your installation contractor.

Heat Pump Water Heaters (HPWH): The installed HPWH must be ENERGY STAR certified and meet the minimum efficiency requirements listed on the rebate application. Quantities are limited to 2 HPWHs per customer installation address. Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027.

Under no circumstances will the total incentive for a single heat pump water heater exceed the offered rebate amount. If an instant rebate was already applied through a participating retailer or distributor through a licensed installation contractor, this rebate cannot be redeemed again. For questions, please consult your installation contractor.

Triple Pane Window(s) Rebate: Installed window(s) must be ENERGY STAR certified replacement triple pane window(s) that have a U-Factor of less than or equal to 0.20 if replacing single pane, single pane with storm windows, or double pane windows, or U-Factor of less than or equal to 0.21 for triple pane windows with grids if replacing single pane, single pane with storm windows, or double pane windows. Existing window(s) must be located as part of the primary building space/envelope only. Windows installed in new construction do not qualify. Self-installed windows do not qualify. Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by February 27, 2027.

Insulation, Attic Access Covers and Ventilation Rebate: Customer must participate in Home Energy SolutionsSM ("HES") to qualify for the rebate. Valid only for areas of a residential building envelope separating conditioned and non-conditioned space. Attic roof decks and rafters do not qualify. Conditioned basements, detached garages, and garages without living space above do not qualify. Areas with health and safety barriers (e.g., mold, presumed asbestos-containing material, etc.) identified through the HES assessment may not be eligible to receive the rebate. Please refer to the Rebate Application for specific insulation, attic access cover, and ventilation requirements and qualifications. Insulation installations must be performed by an approved installer who is part of the Connecticut Insulation Installers Network (CTIIN). Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and March 31, 2027. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by March 31, 2027.

Advanced Duct Sealing Rebate: Customer must participate in HES to qualify for the rebate. Valid only for heating and/or cooling systems with existing ductwork. Valid also when new ductwork is added to an existing system and all [existing and new] ductwork receives Advanced Duct Sealing. Installs of new ductwork where there was no existing ductwork are not eligible for the rebate. Systems installed as part of a residential new construction project do not qualify. A TrueFlow[®] test is required for all systems listed as part of the Rebate Application. Qualifying systems must have an LTO Rate of > 250 CFM. Service must be performed by an approved licensed contractor who is certified by the product manufacturer and is part of the Energize CT Advanced Duct Sealing Network (ADSN). Qualifying Rebate Measure(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and March 31, 2027. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by March 31, 2027.

Appliance Rebate: Customer must participate in HES to qualify for the rebate. Valid only for ENERGY STAR certified clothes washers, refrigerators or freezers purchased and installed after the HES assessment and only if the HES technician has deemed the qualifying appliances eligible for replacement. Limit of one appliance type per customer account address. Appliance(s) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026 and March 31, 2027. Mail in rebate application must be postmarked by March 31, 2027.

Rebate Application: The rebate application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. The Customer and contractor (if applicable) must sign the completed rebate application and submit it along with the required proof of purchase requirements.

Proof of Purchase: A copy of the Customer's invoice itemizing the purchased equipment or materials must accompany each rebate application submission. The invoice must include all listed items as referenced in the Required Document Checklist on the applicable rebate application.

Payment: Please allow up to 90 days for payment. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing on the Rebate Application. Please contact Resource Innovations at **888-855-0282** or **ctrebates@resource-innovations.com** for questions regarding rebate submissions.

Approval and Verification: The Companies reserve the right to verify sales transactions and to have reasonable access to the residence to inspect the measure(s) installed under the Program, prior to or after issuing the rebate payment. Customers also grant the Companies the right to confidentially share account number information for rebate processing procedures.

Tax Liability: The Companies will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Customer as a result of the rebate payment.

Endorsement: The Companies do not endorse any retailer, manufacturer, vendor, contractor, product, or system design in promoting the Programs.

Limitation of Liability: The Companies' liability is limited to paying the rebate specified. The Companies are not liable for any damages arising out of, or resulting from, participation in the Program including but not limited to loss of profits, loss of revenues, failure to realize expected savings, loss of data, loss of business opportunity or similar losses of any kind, as well as any indirect, incidental, punitive, special, or consequential damages, or for any damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in the Program. Applicant understands that all funding for rebates under the Programs derives from the Energy Efficiency Fund which is managed, in part, by the Companies and funded, in part, by a charge on customer energy bills. Neither participating utility guarantees the availability of funding for the Program, nor is responsible for any costs or damages incurred by applicant if funding for the Program or the Energy Efficiency Fund is reduced or eliminated by the State of Connecticut, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, Department of Energy and Environmental Protection or other State of Connecticut action.

The Companies do not warrant the performance of the energy efficiency measures listed on the Rebate Application and do not guarantee that the listed measures will result in energy and/or cost savings.

Customer's Certification: Customer certifies that they have purchased and installed the measure(s) listed on the Rebate Application at the defined location and, if applicable, the measure(s) has been installed by a licensed contractor. The licensed contractor must hold an active and current Connecticut Home Improvement Contractor license. Please visit, elicense.ct.gov/Lookup/LicenseLookup.aspx. Customer agrees that all information is true and that they have conformed to all Program and equipment, material, and/or product requirements listed.

Forward Capacity Market (ISO-NE Capacity Payments): By agreeing to these terms, and as a condition to receiving a rebate pursuant to the Program, the Customer acknowledges and agrees that any and all payments, benefits and/or credits associated with or applicable to the Customer's participation in the Program that is the subject of the agreement in connection with the ISO New England, Inc. Forward Capacity Market ("FCM") or any existing, successor, or replacement markets (including, but not limited to, any and all transitional FCM credits or payments or any and all other capacity-related credits, payments, and/or benefits for which such Customer is eligible) shall be deemed as and from capacity payments, credits, and/or benefits of the Companies as applicable. The Customer hereby assigns to the Companies, as applicable, all of its right, title, and interest in and to any and all such capacity payments, credits, and/or benefits, and agrees to take any and all action, including executing and delivering any and all documentation and/or instruments, as requested by the Companies, as applicable, to evidence the same. FCM means the market for procuring capacity pursuant to ISO-NE Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Section III, Market Rule 1, Section 13, any modifications to the FCM, or any successor or replacement market/capacity procurement process.

Class III Conservation Credits: Any Class III renewable energy credits and/or conservation credits received in connection with the Program shall be retained by the Companies pursuant to the laws of the State of Connecticut and/or applicable Public Utilities Regulatory Authority decision in effect.

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
