

TERMS & CONDITIONS

HULLEMAN People-Driven B2B Advisory

Article 1 – Applicability

These Terms & Conditions apply to all offers, quotations, assignments and agreements of **HULLEMAN People-Driven B2B Advisory**, established in Stegeren, the Netherlands, and registered with the Dutch Chamber of Commerce under number 99594161, hereinafter referred to as “HULLEMAN”.

Any deviations are only valid if agreed in writing.

The applicability of any general terms and conditions of the client is expressly excluded.

Article 2 – Services

HULLEMAN provides services in the fields of commercial advisory, interim management, cross-border support and team development.

The services are provided on a best-efforts basis, unless agreed otherwise in writing.

HULLEMAN performs assignments to the best of its knowledge and ability, with the professionalism and experience expected from a senior commercial advisor.

HULLEMAN does not guarantee specific results.

Article 3 – Formation of the agreement

An agreement is formed after written confirmation or as soon as work has commenced.

Quotations are non-binding.

Article 4 – Fees and payment

The fee is agreed in the assignment confirmation or agreement.

Fees are based on agreed periods or project arrangements and not on hourly calculations.

Invoices are issued per agreed period or monthly in arrears.

Payment term: 14 days.

In case of late payment, the client is automatically in default.

Statutory interest and collection costs apply.

HULLEMAN may suspend its services if payment remains outstanding.

Article 5 – Duration and termination

Notice period: 1 month, unless agreed otherwise.

Fees remain payable during the notice period.

Article 6 – Liability

HULLEMAN is only liable for direct damage resulting from a demonstrable shortcoming.

Liability is limited to the invoice amount of the relevant assignment (excluding VAT), per event and in total.

HULLEMAN is not liable for indirect damages, including consequential damages, loss of profit or lost savings.

HULLEMAN is not liable for damage caused by third parties involved in the execution of the assignment.

Article 7 – Confidentiality

Both parties shall maintain confidentiality of confidential information.

Article 8 – Intellectual Property

All rights remain with HULLEMAN.

Article 9 – Force majeure

No obligation in case of force majeure.

Article 10 – Applicable law and disputes

All agreements are exclusively governed by Dutch law.

Disputes shall be submitted to the competent court in the district where HULLEMAN is established.
