Order Accepting Appraisal Roll; and Setting Tax Rate and Levying a Tax for the Year 2026

The Board of Commissioners ("Board") of Harris County Emergency Services District No. 5 ("District") met at the Board's regular meeting place on August 20, 2026, with a quorum of Commissioners present, as follows:

The Order set out below was introduced and considered by the Board. It was then moved, seconded and unanimously carried that the following Order be adopted:

Whereas, the Chief Appraiser of the Appraisal District in which the District participates has certified the tax roll of the District for the year 2026.

Whereas, a majority of the electors voting in an election held for and within the District have heretofore approved and authorized the levy and collection of a tax for maintenance purposes in the District, for the purpose of providing emergency medical services and ambulance services in the area of the District and for paying costs of proper services and legal fees, and organization and administrative expenses of the District; and

Whereas, the Board has determined that funds are required by the District during the coming year for emergency medical services and ambulance services in the area of the District and for paying costs of proper services and legal fees, and organization and administrative expenses of the District.

Now, therefore, be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners as follows:

I

The Board hereby approves the tax roll of the District as prepared by the tax assessor-collector for the year 2026.

II

The Board hereby levies and directs that there be assessed upon all taxable property within the District an ad valorem tax for maintenance for the year 2026 at the rate of \$0.03 per \$100 of assessed valuation. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 6.33 PERCENT (6.33%) AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$1.79. Taxes shall be due and payable when billed, and shall be paid on or before January 31, 2027.

III

All taxes not paid before February 1, 2027, shall become delinquent on that date, and there shall be added to the tax penalty and interest as provided in V.T.C.A., Property Tax Code.

IV

The Board hereby authorizes and instructs the District's tax assessor-collector to assess and collect the taxes authorized by the Board in this Order.

V

The President or Vice President is authorized to execute and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or Secretary Pro Tempore to attest this order on behalf of the Board and District, and to do any and all things appropriate or necessary to give effect to the intent hereof.
