RULES

1. Please read general rules and regulations page.
2. **All Exhibitors selling animals in the livestock auction must be YQCA certified.**
3. All birds will be checked for disease when they are entered. All birds must also be pullorum-typhoid tested. Sick birds will be sent home.
4. Pairs will consist of one male and one female. Exhibitors may enter no more than 3 pair or single birds per class.
5. Entry fee is \$2.00 per pair, \$1.00 per single and \$3.00 per production pen and \$5.00 for meat pen or meat turkey. Pre-entry forms need to be received by date on entry form.. If the birds are not pre-registered, the superintendent has the right to refuse entry.
6. Mail entries to address on entry form. Make all checks and money orders payable to Chelsea Community Fair.
7. Birds may be cooped on Monday prior to Fair, between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
8. All birds will be judged on Tuesday morning, starting at 1:00 a.m. All birds will be judged according to the Standard of Perfection.
9. We will take every possible precaution to ensure health and safety of the birds. However, Chelsea Community Fair will not be responsible for loss of stock on exhibit at the Fair.
10. ALL EXHIBITS must remain on display until 8:00 A.M. on Sunday following Fair.
Please pick up exhibits at 8:00 A.M. on Sunday following Fair.
11. Superintendent cannot be held responsible for poultry left after 9:00 am.
12. Feed and water will be provided by Chelsea Community Fair. However, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to feed and water their birds daily. The exhibitor must also provide feed and water containers that the birds cannot tip over. If an exhibitor chooses not to take care of their birds, the exhibitor may be asked not to exhibit the following year.
13. Production Pens will consist of three females of laying age (poultry, duck, geese)
14. Meat pens will consist of three birds of the same sex.
15. Individual meat chickens cannot exceed 10 lbs each. Minimum 3 lbs each.
Individual meat ducks must be minimum of 4 lbs each with no maximum.
Individual meat turkeys must be a minimum of 16 lbs each with no maximum.
16. Meat Turkey and Meat Duck will consist of a single Tom.
17. Each exhibitor may enter one meat pen & one meat turkey.
18. Set-up will be at 2:00 p.m. the Sunday prior to Fair.
19. Exhibitors with poultry left after 9 a.m. will be responsible for hauling their pens back to the Washtenaw County Fairgrounds and will be held responsible for loss or damages.
20. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean their pens as needed during the week.

Learning Objective: Demonstrate through their project what they have learned raising poultry.
