THE YEAR IN REVIEW

In 2025, PPT4ed continued to expand its impact by delivering high-quality, evidence-based education to therapists, educators, and community partners. Through seven continuing education courses and multiple community training initiatives, we reached over 150 therapists and 200 educators, equipping them with practical strategies to better support children with diverse developmental needs.

This year also included expanded national and advocacy efforts, with our team providing training on whole body vibration therapy to more than 20 hospitals and private practices across the country. Our Bahamas outreach efforts continued, including our 2025 trip supporting local needs and planning for a new school design in 2026.

PPT4ed also participated in APTA Advocacy Day in Washington, D.C., as well as advocacy meetings in Tallahassee alongside members of the Florida Therapy Consortium to support access to therapy services for children with disabilities. Additionally, we contributed to a Rifton panel discussion focused on neurodiversity.

This year focused on intentional growth, strengthening key partnerships with organizations such as the Early Learning Coalition, FAU STEM Teacher Academy, and expanding both in-person and virtual learning opportunities. Feedback across all programs was overwhelmingly positive, with participants highlighting the immediate applicability and real-world relevance of the content.

As we look ahead, PPT4ed remains committed to building on this momentum—expanding access to education, supporting providers and families, and continuing to create meaningful, lasting impact in the communities we serve.

HIGHLIGHTS IN 2025

Spring Highlight

PPT4ed expanded its impact through our One Step Ahead orthotics webinar, Handle with Care infant development course, and a presentation at the FAU STEM Teacher Academy. We also presented two educational sessions at the Early Learning Coalition Empower Conference in May 2025 and provided whole body vibration therapy training to more than 20 hospitals and private practices across the country—equipping therapists and educators with practical strategies to support children with diverse needs.

Summer Highlight

PPT4ed expanded its reach through presentations with the Early Learning Coalition and our Play to Talk webinar, while continuing our Bahamas outreach with a 2025 trip supporting local needs and planning for a new school design in 2026—further strengthening support for children, families, and providers.

Fall Highlight

PPT4ed hosted our Treatment of Torticollis course, equipping therapists with evidence-based strategies to support infants' development. We also engaged in advocacy efforts through APTA Advocacy Day in Washington, D.C., along with meetings in Tallahassee alongside the Florida Therapy Consortium to support access to therapy services for children with disabilities.

Winter Highlight

PPT4ed presented on neurodiversity through a panel discussion with Rifton and focused on strategic planning for 2026 initiatives. We also completed construction of our training room, which opened in January 2026 as a shared community space for caregiver education, professional training, and learning events that support strong, healthy families.
