Pastor's Corner

Sunday, March 29, 2026

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

I want to invite you to attend the Holy Week three days of special liturgies: Holy Triduum- Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. We will be baptizing 90 catechumens in our parish. Please come and pray for them.

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday, marking Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The crowds joyfully waved palm branches and shouted, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Matthew 21:9). Yet, in a few short days, many of those same voices would turn away, leaving Jesus to face the cross. This contrast reminds us that following Christ is not always easy—it calls for commitment, courage, and faith.

Palm Sunday invites us to reflect on how we welcome Jesus into our lives. Do we greet Him with genuine joy, or do we only follow Him when it is convenient? True discipleship means walking with Him even in trials, carrying our own "crosses" with patience and love, and living our faith authentically in our families, workplaces, and communities.

As we begin Holy Week, let us strive to live the message of Palm Sunday by embracing humility, forgiveness, and service. Let us bring our faith into daily actions, showing love to those around us, offering compassion to the suffering, and proclaiming through our deeds that Jesus is Lord of our hearts—not only on Sundays, but every day. By doing so, we will be able to enter the joy of Easter with hearts renewed, ready to share the hope and peace of Christ with the world.

May this Holy Week deepen your love for Christ and inspire you to live each day as a faithful disciple.


Hôm nay, Chúa nhật Lễ Lá, chúng ta tưởng niệm Chúa Giêsu long trọng tiến vào thành Giêrusalem. Dân chúng hân hoan vẫy cành lá và reo lên: "Hosanna! Đấng nhân danh Chúa đến, thật đáng chúc tụng!" (Gioan 12,13). Thế nhưng, chỉ vài ngày sau, chính những người hôm nay reo hò sẽ quay lưng, bỏ mặc Ngài trước thập giá. Điều này nhắc nhở chúng ta rằng đi theo Chúa không phải lúc nào cũng dễ dàng; cần lòng kiên trung, niềm tin và sẵn sàng hy sinh.

Lễ Lá hôm nay mời gọi mỗi chúng ta tự hỏi: Chúng ta có đón nhận Chúa Giêsu trong đời sống hằng ngày, không chỉ trong niềm vui và thuận tiện, mà còn trong những thử thách và khó khăn? Tuần Thánh sắp đến là cơ hội để chúng ta sống khiêm nhường, tha thứ và phục vụ, mang những "cành lá" đức tin ấy vào gia đình, xóm làng và nơi làm việc.

Hãy để niềm vui chào đón Chúa Giêsu dẫn chúng ta bước theo Ngài trong suốt Tuần Thánh, sống yêu thương, kiên trung với đức tin và trở thành chứng nhân sống động của Chúa nơi đời thường.

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!

Quiero invitarle a asistir a los tres días de liturgias especiales de la Semana Santa: Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Sábado Santo. En nuestra parroquia, se bautizarán 90 catecúmenos. Por favor, venga y ore por ellos.

Hoy celebramos el Domingo de Ramos, recordando la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. La multitud agitaba ramas de palma y gritaba: "¡Hosanna! ¡Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor!" (Mateo 21,9). Sin embargo, pocos días después, muchos de esos mismos que hoy lo aclamaban lo abandonarían, dejándolo frente a la cruz. Este contraste nos recuerda que seguir a Cristo no siempre es fácil; requiere compromiso, valentía y fe constante.


El Domingo de Ramos nos invita a reflexionar sobre cómo recibimos a Jesús en nuestra vida diaria. ¿Lo acogemos con alegría sincera, o solo cuando nos resulta cómodo y conveniente? Ser discípulos de Cristo significa caminar con Él incluso en medio de pruebas, cargar nuestras propias "cruces" con paciencia y amor, y vivir nuestra fe de manera auténtica en la familia, el trabajo y la comunidad.



KEEPING SUNDAY | ALL DAY

As we take time each week to celebrate the Paschal Mystery in the Eucharist and to rest from the burdens of our daily lives, we remind ourselves that we are made in the image and likeness of God who "rested on the seventh day from all the work he had undertaken" (Gn 2:2).

To celebrate the Lord's Day more fully, consider trying the following:

- Do not use Sunday as your catch-all day for errands and household chores.
- Share a family meal after Mass. Have the whole family join in the preparation and cleanup.
- Go for a walk or bike ride and give thanks to God for the beauty of nature.
- Spend time reading the Bible or a spiritual book.
- Pray the Rosary or the Liturgy of the Hours, alone or with others.
- Visit parishioners and others who are homebound.
- Read Bible stories to your children.
- Turn off your gadgets and enjoy the silence
