



Pastor's Corner

Trinity Sunday, June 15, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Trinity!

Today, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we profess our faith in the Triune God each time we make the Sign of the Cross. God the Father created us, Jesus Christ the Son redeemed us, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies us. Today is also Father's Day—a day to honor and give thanks for all fathers. Let us express our gratitude to the fathers who have sacrificed their lives to work and provide for their families. The Book of Sirach teaches us: "*Whoever honors his father atones for sins.*" May God bless and pour out His abundant grace upon all our fathers.

Happy Father's Day!

The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. The doctrine teaches that there are, in One God, three distinct and equal Divine Persons sharing the same divine nature. Our mind cannot grasp this doctrine, which teaches that $1 + 1 + 1 = 1$ and not 3. But we believe in this mystery because Jesus who is God taught it clearly, the evangelists recorded it, the Fathers of the Church believed and explained it, and the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, guided by the Holy Spirit, defined it as a dogma of Christian faith.

Importance in Christian life:

- All prayers in the Church begin in the name of the Holy Trinity and end glorifying the Trinity.
- All Sacraments are administered (we are Baptized, Confirmed, Anointed, our sins are forgiven and our marriage blessed), in the Name of the Holy Trinity.
- Church bells can ring thrice daily, to remind us to pray to the Holy Trinity.
- We bless ourselves, and the priest blesses us, in the name of the Holy Trinity.

The Holy Trinity in the Bible: There are only vague and hidden references to the Trinity in the Old Testament. But the New Testament gives clear teachings on Holy Trinity.

- At the Annunciation, God the Father sends His angel to Mary, God the Holy Spirit overshadows her, and God the Son becomes incarnate in her womb.
- At the Baptism of Jesus, when the Son receives baptism from John the Baptist, the Father's Voice is heard, and the Holy Spirit appears as a dove.
- At the Ascension, Jesus gives the missionary command to his disciples to baptize those who believe, "in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

In John, chapters 15-18, we have a detailed account of Jesus' teaching of the role of each person of the Holy Trinity. 1) God the Father creates and provides for His creatures. 2) God the Son redeems us and reconciles us with God. 3) God the Holy Spirit sanctifies us, strengthens us, teaches us, and guides us to God.

This Trinity Sunday let us respect ourselves and others because everyone is the temple of the Holy Spirit where all the three Persons of the Holy Trinity abide. Let us have the firm conviction that the Trinitarian God abides in us and that He is the source of our hope, courage, and strength, and is our destination. Let us practice the Trinitarian relationship of love and unity in the family relationships of father, mother, and children, because by baptism we become children of God and members of God's Trinitarian family.

Hôm nay ngày Lễ Kính Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi chúng ta tuyên xưng Chúa Ba Ngôi khi ta làm dấu thánh giá. Chúa Cha đã dựng nên chúng ta, Đức Chúa Giêsu Đấng Cứu chuộc chúng ta và Đức Chúa Thánh Thần Đấng thánh hóa chúng ta. Hôm nay cũng là ngày Hiền Phụ tri ân các người Cha/ Chúng ta hãy tri ân những người cha đã hy sinh cuộc đời để làm việc nuôi sống gia đình. Sách Đức Huấn Ca dạy chúng ta rằng 'Ai yêu mến Cha mình thì đền bù tội lỗi. Nguyện xin Chúa chúc lành và ban muôn ơn lành cho các người cha của chúng ta. Happy Father's Day.

Hôm nay Chúa Nhật Mừng Kính Lễ Chúa Ba Ngôi là Mẫu Nhiệm, là căn bản của niềm tin Kitô Giáo, chúng ta không thể nào hiểu bằng khối óc nhưng mà chỉ bằng trái tim. Mẫu nhiệm Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi dạy chúng ta Một Thiên Chúa và Ba Ngôi riêng biệt cùng bản tính và uy quyền ngang nhau. Trí óc chúng ta không thể nào có thể hiểu được, nhưng chúng ta tin vào mẫu nhiệm này vì Chúa Giêsu là Thiên Chúa đã dạy cho chúng ta cách rõ ràng, các Thánh Sứ đã ghi lại và các Thánh Phụ đã tin nhận và cố gắng cắt nghĩa trong Công Đồng Nicêa và Constatinô đã được hướng dẫn bởi Chúa Thánh Thần và là tín điều của Đức Tin Công Giáo.

Mẫu Nhiệm Chúa Ba Ngôi rất quan trọng trong cuộc sống của Người Kitô hữu vì tất cả các kinh nguyện của Giáo Hội bắt đầu bằng Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi và chấm dứt bằng việc ca tụng Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi. Tất cả các Bí Tích được thông ban chúng ta được Rửa Tội ban phép Thêm Sức, được sức dầu và Bí Tích Hoà Giải và Bí Tích Hôn Phối đều là Nhân Danh Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi. Chúng ta làm dấu, và các linh mục ban phép lành cho chúng ta bằng tên Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi.

Mẫu Nhiệm Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi trong Kinh Thánh đặc biệt trong Tân Ước cho chúng ta về sự giáo huấn của Chúa Ba Ngôi. 1) Lúc Truyền Tin, Thiên Chúa Cha sai Thiên Thần đến với Đức Mẹ, Chúa Thánh Thần đã bao bọc Đức Mẹ và Thiên Chúa Con được đầu thai trong cung lòng Đức Trinh Nữ. 2) Lúc Chúa Giêsu chịu Phép Rửa, khi Chúa Con nhận lãnh Bí Tích Rửa từ Thánh Gioan Tiên Hô, tiếng Thiên Chúa Cha được từ trời và Chúa Thánh Thần được hiện ra dưới hình chim bồ câu.

Mừng Lễ Chúa Ba Ngôi hôm nay chúng ta được mời gọi hãy kính trọng lẫn nhau và người khác vì mọi người là đền thờ của Chúa Thánh Thần nơi Ba Ngôi Thiên Chúa ngự trị. Chúng ta hãy tin vững vàng rằng Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi đang hiện diện trong chúng ta vì Ngài là nguồn hy vọng, can đảm và sức mạnh và con đường tối hậu. Chúng ta cũng hãy thực hành tình yêu Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi nơi gia đình qua sự liên hệ với cha mẹ và con cái vì qua Bí Tích Rửa Tội chúng ta được trở nên những phần tử của gia đình Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi.

Notas del Párroco

Domingo de La Trinidad, junio 15, 2025

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas en La Trinidad!

Hoy, en la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, profesamos nuestra fe en el Dios Uno y Trino cada vez que hacemos la señal de la cruz. Dios Padre nos creó, Jesucristo el Hijo nos redimió, y el Espíritu Santo nos santifica. Hoy también celebramos el Día del Padre, un día para honrar y agradecer a todos los padres. Expresemos nuestra gratitud a aquellos padres que han sacrificado su vida trabajando para mantener a sus familias. El Libro del Eclesiástico nos enseña: "*El que honra a su padre expía sus pecados.*" Que Dios bendiga y derrame abundantes gracias sobre todos nuestros padres. ¡Feliz Día del Padre!

El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad es una doctrina básica de la fe en el cristianismo, comprensible no con nuestras cabezas sino con nuestros corazones. La doctrina enseña que hay, en un Dios, tres personas divinas distintas e iguales que comparten la misma naturaleza divina. Nuestra mente no puede comprender esta doctrina, que enseña que $1+1+1=1$ y no 3. Pero creemos en este misterio porque Jesús, quien es Dios, lo enseñó claramente, los evangelistas lo registraron, los Padres de la Iglesia lo creyeron y lo explicaron, y los Concilios de Nicea y Constantinopla, guiados por el Espíritu Santo, lo definieron como un dogma de la fe cristiana.

Importancia en la vida cristiana:

- Todas las oraciones en la Iglesia comienzan en el nombre de la Santísima Trinidad y terminan de glorificar a la Trinidad.
- Todos los sacramentos son administrados (somos bautizados, confirmados, ungidos, nuestros pecados son perdonados y nuestro matrimonio bendecido), en el Nombre de la Santísima Trinidad.
- Las campanas de la iglesia pueden sonar tres veces al día, para recordarnos que debemos orar a la Santísima Trinidad.
- Nos bendecimos a nosotros mismos, y el sacerdote nos bendice, en el nombre de la Santísima Trinidad.

La Santísima Trinidad en la Biblia: Solo hay referencias vagas y ocultas a la Trinidad en el Antiguo Testamento. Pero el Nuevo Testamento da enseñanzas claras sobre la Santísima Trinidad.

- En la Anunciación, Dios el Padre envía a su ángel a María, Dios el Espíritu Santo la opaca y Dios el Hijo se encarna en su vientre.
- En el Bautismo de Jesús, cuando el Hijo recibe el bautismo de Juan el Bautista, se escucha la Voz del Padre y el Espíritu Santo aparece como una paloma.
- En la Ascensión, Jesús da la orden misionera a sus discípulos de que bauticen a los que creen "en el Nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo".

En Juan, capítulos 15-18, tenemos un relato detallado de la enseñanza de Jesús sobre el papel de cada persona de la Santísima Trinidad. **1)** Dios el Padre crea y provee para Sus criaturas. **2)** Dios el Hijo nos redime y nos reconcilia con Dios. **3)** Dios el Espíritu Santo nos santifica, nos fortalece, nos enseña y nos guía a Dios.

Este domingo de la Trinidad, respetémonos a nosotros mismos y a los demás, porque todos somos el templo del Espíritu Santo donde residen las tres Personas de la Santísima Trinidad. Tengamos la firme convicción de que el Dios trinitario permanece en nosotros y que Él es la fuente de nuestra esperanza, valor y fortaleza, y es nuestro destino final. Practiquemos la relación trinitaria de amor y unidad en las relaciones familiares de padre, madre e hijos, porque al bautizar nos convertimos en hijos de Dios y miembros de la familia trinitaria de Dios.

¡Sinceramente suyo en Dios trinitario y Nuestra Señora Guadalupe!




