Pastor's Corner

Sunday June 29, 2025, Feast of St Peter and St Paul

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

As we bid farewell to Father Ben Hoang and Sister Hang Le at 9:30am mass today. We thank them for their dedication and service to our parish in the past 3 years for Father Ben Hoang and 7 years for Sister Hang Le. We pray that the Lord may bless them with joy, peace and love as they continue their service for the Church. Good luck to you Fr Ben and Sister Hang Le.

Today, the Church celebrates two great pillars of our faiths, Saint Peter and Saint Paul—whose lives and ministries were instrumental in building the early Church. Their feast reminds us of the power of conversion, mission, and unity in Christ.

Peter, the fisherman called by Jesus, shows us the journey of faith from doubt to firm leadership. Despite his weaknesses—denying Jesus three times—he was forgiven and entrusted with the mission to “feed my sheep” (John 21:17). Peter symbolizes the call to serve others humbly and courageously, even when we stumble.

Paul, once a fierce persecutor of Christians, experienced a radical conversion on the road to Damascus. He became the “Apostle to the Gentiles,” zealously spreading the Gospel far beyond Jewish communities. Paul teaches us that no one is beyond God’s grace and that transformation opens the door to a life dedicated to Christ’s mission.

Together, Peter and Paul represent the universality of the Church. Peter often stands for the Jewish Christian community, while Paul embodies the Gentile mission. Their collaboration shows that the Church thrives in diversity and unity under Christ’s leadership.

As we honor their witness, we are invited to reflect on our own calling. Are we ready to be transformed by God’s grace like Paul? Are we willing to serve others with the humility and love Peter displayed? Their example challenges us to be bold in our faith, to persevere through trials, and to build up the Body of Christ in our own time.

May their prayers inspire us to be faithful disciples, united in mission and steadfast in hope.

Chúa Nhật ngày 29 tháng 6, 2025

Kính Hai Thánh Tông Đồ Phêrô và Phaolô

Kính thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em

Hôm nay Chúa Nhật sau thánh lễ 9:30 sáng chúng ta sẽ có tiệc tiền Cha Ben Hoàng và Sơ Hằng Lê. Giáo xứ xin chân thành tri ân tới Cha Ben đã phục vụ giáo xứ trong suốt 3 năm qua và Sơ Hằng trong suốt 7 năm qua. Nguyên xin Chúa qua lời chuyển cầu của Đức Mẹ La Vang ban muôn ơn lành trên Cha và Sơ trong sứ vụ mới.

Hôm nay, Hội Thánh mừng kính hai vị tông đồ vĩ đại: Thánh Phêrô và Thánh Phaolô, những nền tảng vững chắc của đức tin Kitô giáo. Cuộc đời và sứ vụ của các ngài đã góp phần xây dựng và phát triển Hội Thánh sơ khai.

Thánh Phêrô, người đánh cá được Chúa gọi, đã trải qua hành trình đức tin từ sự yếu đuối đến lòng can đảm và trách nhiệm lãnh đạo. Dù từng chối bỏ Chúa ba lần, nhưng ngài được Chúa tha thứ và trao sứ mạng “chăn dắt chiên con của Thầy” (Ga 21,17). Thánh Phêrô dạy chúng ta biết khiêm nhường và can đảm phục vụ anh chị em dù gặp thử thách.

Thánh Phaolô, từ một kẻ bắt đạo, đã được biến đổi hoàn toàn trên đường đến Đa-mách. Ngài trở thành “tông đồ dân ngoại,” không ngừng truyền giảng Tin Mừng đến những nơi xa xôi. Thánh Phaolô cho thấy không ai nằm ngoài vòng tay thương xót của Thiên Chúa, và sự hoán cải mở ra một cuộc sống mới đầy nhiệt huyết phục vụ Chúa.

Hai vị thánh đại diện cho sự phổ quát của Hội Thánh: Thánh Phêrô gắn bó với cộng đồng Do Thái, còn Thánh Phaolô mang sứ vụ đến với dân ngoại. Sự hợp tác của các ngài cho thấy Hội Thánh phát triển trong sự đa dạng và hiệp nhất dưới sự hướng dẫn của Chúa Kitô.

Nhân ngày lễ này, chúng ta hãy suy nghĩ về ơn gọi của mình. Chúng ta có sẵn sàng để được Thiên Chúa biến đổi như Thánh Phaolô? Chúng ta có dám phục vụ và yêu thương như Thánh Phêrô? Xin các ngài cầu bầu để chúng ta luôn trung thành làm chứng cho Tin Mừng với lòng can đảm và hy vọng.

Domingo Junio 29, 2025 Fiesta de San Pedro y San Pablo

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!

Al despedirnos del Padre Ben Hoang y de la Hermana Hang Le en la misa de las 9:30 a.m. de hoy, les damos gracias por su dedicación y servicio a nuestra parroquia durante estos últimos 3 años para el Padre Ben Hoang y 7 años para la Hermana Hang Le. Oramos para que el Señor los bendiga con alegría, paz y amor mientras continúan su servicio a la Iglesia. ¡Les deseamos mucha suerte, Padre Ben y Hermana Hang Le!

Hoy celebramos a dos grandes pilares de nuestra fe: San Pedro y San Pablo, cuyas vidas y ministerios fueron fundamentales para la fundación y crecimiento de la Iglesia primitiva. Su fiesta nos recuerda el poder de la conversión, la misión y la unidad en Cristo.

Pedro, el pescador llamado por Jesús, nos muestra el camino de la fe desde la duda hasta un liderazgo firme. A pesar de sus debilidades —como negar a Jesús tres veces— fue perdonado y confiado con la misión de “apacentar mis ovejas” (Juan 21,17). Pedro simboliza la vocación a servir a los demás con humildad y valentía, incluso cuando fallamos.

Pablo, antes perseguidor de los cristianos, experimentó una conversión radical en el camino a Damasco. Se convirtió en el “Apóstol de los gentiles,” llevando con entusiasmo el Evangelio más allá de la comunidad judía. Pablo nos enseña que nadie está fuera del alcance de la gracia de Dios, y que la transformación personal abre la puerta para dedicarse plenamente a la misión de Cristo.

Juntos, Pedro y Pablo representan la universalidad de la Iglesia. Pedro está vinculado a la comunidad judía, mientras Pablo encarna la misión a los gentiles. Su colaboración nos muestra que la Iglesia crece en la diversidad y la unidad bajo la guía de Cristo.

Al honrar su testimonio, somos invitados a reflexionar sobre nuestro propio llamado. ¿Estamos dispuestos a dejarnos transformar por la gracia de Dios como Pablo? ¿Estamos listos para servir con humildad y amor como Pedro? 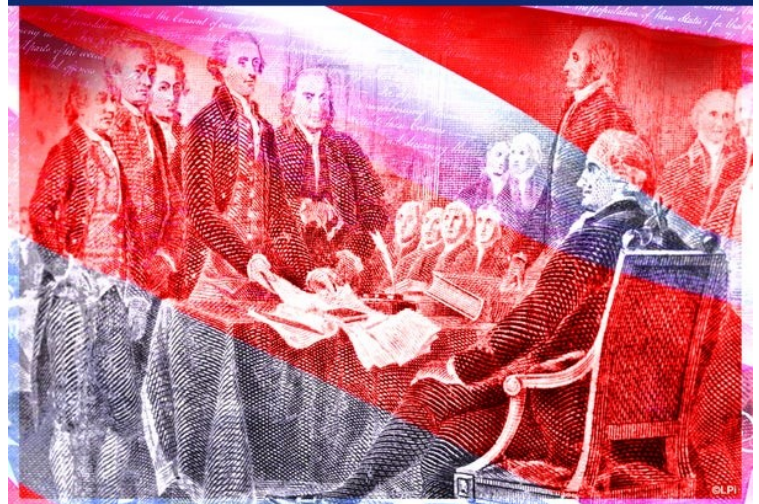

- Visit parishioners and others who are homebound.
- Read Bible stories to your children.
- Turn off your gadgets and enjoy the silence
