Pastor's Corner

Pentecost Sunday, June 8, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, on the Solemnity of Pentecost, the Church invites all her children to rejoice, for it is the Birthday of the Church. Together with the priests and deacons, we extend our congratulations to the 28 adults who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at the 9:30 AM Mass today. We kindly ask all of you to continue supporting our parish. May the Holy Spirit pour out His sevenfold gifts upon all of you.

Pentecost literally means 50th. It is a Feast celebrated on the 50th day after the Passover Feast by the Jews, and a Feast celebrated on the 50th day after the Feast of the Resurrection of Jesus by the Christians. The Jewish Pentecost was originally a post-harvest thanksgiving feast. Later, the Jews included in it the remembrance of God's Covenants with Noah after the Deluge and with Moses at Mt. Sinai. On the day of Pentecost **1)** The Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary as fiery tongues; **2)** The frightened apostles were transformed into fiery preachers and evangelizers and were given the gift of tongues by a special anointing of the Holy Spirit; **3)** The listeners experienced a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit through the apostles' gift of tongues: they heard Peter speaking in their native languages; **4)** The early Christians became powerful witnesses and brave martyrs for their faith in Jesus.

The role of the Holy Spirit in Christian life: **1)** As an indwelling God, He makes us His Living Temples (I Cor 3:16); **2)** As a strengthening God, He empowers us in our fight against temptations and in our mission of bearing witness to Christ by our living transparent Christian lives; **3)** As a sanctifying God, He makes us holy through the Sacraments: **a)** He makes us children of God and heirs of heaven through Baptism, **b)** He makes us temples of God, warriors and defenders of the Faith, through Confirmation, **c)** He enables us to be reconciled to God by pardoning our sins through Reconciliation, and **d)** He gives us spiritual nourishment via the Holy Eucharist by converting bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood through Epiclesis; **4)** As a teaching and guiding God, He clarifies and constantly reminds us of Christ's teachings; **5)** As a listening and talking God, He listens to our prayers and enables us to pray, and He speaks to us mainly through the Bible; **6)** As a giver of gifts, He gives us His gifts, fruits, and charisms. On this Feast of the Holy Spirit, take heed to ourselves and permit the Holy Spirit to take control of our lives by **1)** constantly remembering His holy presence and behaving well; **2)** by praying for His daily anointing so that we may fight against our temptations and control our evil tendencies, evil habits, and addictions; **4)** asking the help of the Holy Spirit to do good for others and to be reconciled to God and others every day.

Chúa Nhật Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống, ngày 8 tháng 6, 2025

Quý Ông Bà Anh Chị Em thân mến!

Hôm nay Chúa Nhật Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống, Giáo Hội mời gọi con cái hãy vui mừng vì là ngày Sinh Nhật của Hội Thánh. Cùng với quý cha quý thầy sáu xin chúc mừng tới 28 người lớn sẽ được lãnh bí tích thêm sức vào thánh lễ 9:30 sáng nay. Xin quý ông bà anh chị em tiếp tục đóng góp cho giáo xứ. Nguyên xin Chúa Thánh Thần ban nhiều bầy ơn trên toàn thể Quý Ông Bà Anh Chị Em.

Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống mừng vào ngày thứ 50 sau khi Lễ Vượt qua của người Do Thái và được người Kitô Giáo mừng vào 50 ngày sau khi Chúa Kitô Phục Sinh. Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống của người Do Thái bắt nguồn từ hậu mùa gặt lễ tạ ơn. Sau này người Do Thái thêm nó vào sự tưởng nhớ giao ước mà Chúa đã ký kết với Ông Noê và Ông Moisé ở núi Sinai.

Trong ngày Lễ Hiện Xuống Chúa Thánh Thần ngự trên các Tông Đồ và Đức Mẹ với những lưỡi lửa. Các Tông Đồ đang sợ hãi bỗng nhiên được đổi mới bằng những người rao giảng hùng hồn và những người loan báo tin mừng được ban cho những ơn bằng lưỡi lửa và được Chúa Thánh Thần xúc dầu. Những người nghe cảm nghiệm được việc xúc dầu mới của Chúa Thánh Thần qua việc các Tông Đồ với những ngôn ngữ mới, họ đã nghe Thánh Phêrô nói bằng tiếng thổ âm. Những người Kitô hữu tiên khởi trở nên những chứng nhân cam đảm làm chứng cho niềm tin của Chúa Kitô.

Nhân ngày Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống hôm nay, chúng ta hãy cầu xin Chúa Thánh Thần làm chủ cuộc đời chúng ta để chúng ta chống lại các cơn cám dỗ, hầu chúng ta có thể làm chứng nhân của tình yêu Chúa Kitô cho tha nhân.

Notas del Párroco

Domingo de Pentecostés, 8 de Junio de 2025

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!

Hoy, en la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, la Iglesia invita a todos sus hijos a alegrarse, porque es el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Junto con los sacerdotes y diáconos, felicitamos a los 28 adultos que recibirán el Sacramento de la Confirmación en la misa de las 9:30 de la mañana. Pedimos a todos los hermanos y hermanas que continúen apoyando a la parroquia. Que el Espíritu Santo derrame abundantemente sus siete dones sobre todos ustedes.

Pentecostés significa literalmente el 50°. Es una fiesta celebrada el día 50 después de la fiesta de la Pascua de los judíos, y una fiesta celebrada el día 50 después de la fiesta de la resurrección de Jesús por los cristianos. El Pentecostés judío fue originalmente una fiesta de acción de gracias posterior a la cosecha. Más tarde, los judíos incluyeron en ella el recuerdo de los pactos de Dios con Noé después del diluvio y con Moisés en el monte. Sinaí En el día de Pentecostés **1)** El Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los apóstoles y la Santísima Virgen María como lenguas ardientes; **2)** Los espantosos apóstoles se transformaron en fieros predicadores y evangelizadores y se les dio el don de lenguas por una unción especial del Espíritu Santo; **3)** Los oyentes experimentaron una nueva unción del Espíritu Santo a través del don de lenguas de los apóstoles: escucharon a Pedro hablar en sus idiomas nativos; **4)** Los primeros cristianos se convirtieron en testigos poderosos y valientes mártires por su fe en Jesús.

El papel del Espíritu Santo en la vida cristiana: **1)** Como Dios residente, Él nos hace Sus Templos Vivientes (I Cor 3:16); **2)** Como un Dios fortalecedor, Él nos da poder en nuestra lucha contra las tentaciones y en nuestra misión de dar testimonio de Cristo por nuestras vidas cristianas transparentes y vivas; **3)** Como un Dios santificador, Él nos hace santos a través de los Sacramentos: **a)** Nos hace hijos de Dios y herederos del cielo a través del Bautismo, **b)** Nos hace templos de Dios, guerreros y defensores de la Fe, a través de la Confirmación, **c)** Él nos permite reconciliarnos con Dios perdonando nuestros pecados a través de la Reconciliación, y **d)** nos da alimento espiritual a través de la Sagrada Eucaristía al convertir el pan y el vino en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús a través de la Epiclesis; **4)** Como un Dios que enseña y guía, Él nos aclara y nos recuerda constantemente las enseñanzas de Cristo; **5)** Como un Dios que escucha y habla, Él escucha nuestras oraciones y nos permite orar, y nos habla principalmente a través de la Biblia; **6)** Como dador de regalos, Él nos da sus regalos, frutos y carismas.

En esta Fiesta del Espíritu Santo, cuidémonos y permitamos que el Espíritu Santo tome el control de nuestras vidas al **1)** recordar constantemente Su presencia santa y comportarse bien; **2)** orando por su unción diaria para que podamos luchar contra nuestras tentaciones y controlar nuestras malas tendencias, malos hábitos y adicciones; **3)** pedir la ayuda del Espíritu Santo para hacer el bien a los demás y reconciliarse con Dios y con los demás todos los días.

¡Sinceramente suyo en Espíritu Santo, el Señor resucitado y en Nuestra Señora de La Vang!

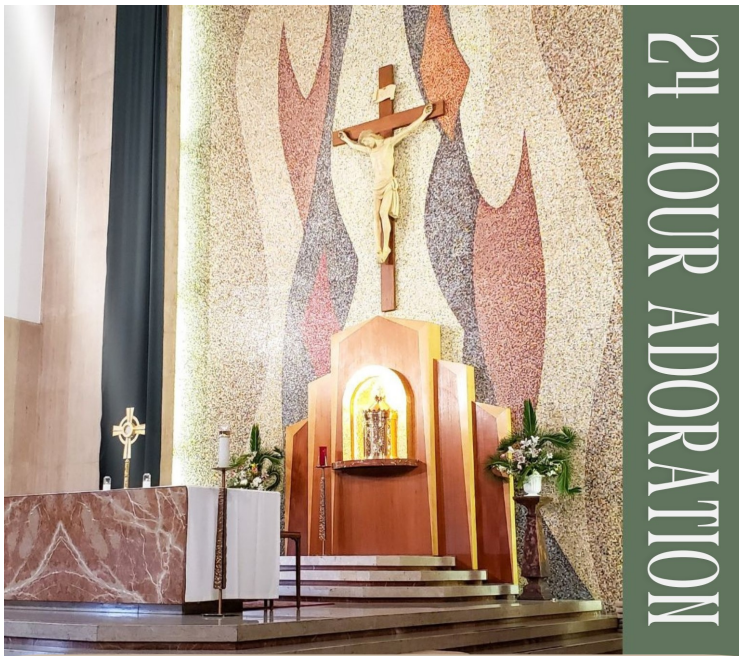

The **Order of Christian Initiation** is a process for becoming Catholic or completing the Sacraments of Initiation. Through the process of becoming Catholic, one discovers life's new meaning and purpose. It is a time of prayer, study, reflection, faith sharing, and becoming an active member of our parish community. All are welcome!

Generally, this process is for:

- Adults and children over the age of 7 who are not baptized.
- Adults from another Christian tradition, who are baptized, but considering becoming part of the Catholic faith community.
- Adults who were baptized Catholic as infants, but never received their First Holy Communion or Confirmation.
