Pastor's Corner

Sunday, August 31, 2025

Dear Parishioners of St Columban!

This Sunday's Gospel offers us a powerful lesson in humility and the heart of true Christian living. Jesus says, "*When you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place...*" (Luke 14:10). In a world that often values status, recognition, and self-promotion, Jesus invites us to a different path—the way of humility, service, and trust in God's grace.

True greatness in the eyes of God does not come from sitting in places of honor, but from choosing to serve others without seeking reward. Jesus himself, though Lord of all, took the lowest place—washing feet, dining with sinners, and ultimately giving His life for us. His example calls us to reflect: Do we seek the spotlight, or do we quietly love and serve?

In our daily lives—at home, at work, at school, in the parish—there are countless opportunities to “take the lower place.” This could mean letting others go first, listening more than speaking, offering help without being asked, or doing good when no one is watching. These are the humble actions that build up the Kingdom of God.

The first reading from Sirach echoes this same wisdom: “*Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God*” (Sir 3:18). When we recognize that everything we have—our talents, our time, even our breath—is a gift from God, we become more grateful and more generous.

This week, let us ask the Lord to give us humble hearts—hearts that love freely, serve quietly, and give thanks constantly. May our lives be living parables of Christ’s love, who came not to be served, but to serve.

Lá Thư Cha Chánh Xứ

Chúa Nhật ngày **31 tháng 8, 2025**

Quí Ông Bà Anh Chị em thân mến!

Tin Mừng Chúa Nhật hôm nay (Lc 14,1.7-14) mang đến cho chúng ta một bài học sâu sắc về đức khiêm nhường. Chúa Giêsu dạy: "*Khi được mời, hãy vào ngồi chỗ cuối...*" (Lc 14,10). Trong một thế giới thường đề cao danh vọng, địa vị và thành công, Chúa lại chỉ cho chúng ta con đường ngược lại—con đường của khiêm nhường, phục vụ, và tín thác vào Thiên Chúa.

Chúa Giêsu không chỉ giảng dạy bằng lời nói, nhưng chính Người đã sống trọn vẹn tinh thần đó. Ngài, là Con Thiên Chúa, đã cúi xuống rửa chân cho các môn đệ, ngồi ăn với người tội lỗi, và cuối cùng hiến dâng mạng sống trên thập giá vì yêu thương nhân loại. Chính nhờ sự khiêm hạ ấy mà Thiên Chúa đã siêu tôn Người trên hết mọi loài.

Lời dạy của Chúa hôm nay mời gọi mỗi chúng ta nhìn lại cách sống của mình. Chúng ta có đang tìm chỗ nhất, chỗ cao, hay chúng ta dám chọn lối sống âm thầm phục vụ và quảng đại yêu thương? Khiêm nhường không có nghĩa là tự hạ thấp mình, nhưng là nhận biết sự thật rằng mọi sự ta có đều là hồng ân Thiên Chúa ban. Và khi sống trong tâm tình ấy, ta dễ dàng mở lòng đón nhận, tha thứ và giúp đỡ anh chị em xung quanh. Bài đọc I từ sách Huấn Ca cũng nhắc lại điều này: "*Càng làm lớn, con càng phải tự hạ, như thế con sẽ được đẹp lòng Đức Chúa*" (Hc 3,18). Khiêm nhường là nền tảng của sự khôn ngoan, là cửa ngõ dẫn vào Nước Trời.

Trong tuần mới này, xin Chúa ban cho mỗi người chúng ta một tâm hồn khiêm nhường và rộng mở—biết sống vì người khác, biết âm thầm phục vụ, và luôn tin thác vào Chúa là Đáng sể ban phần thưởng xứng đáng cho những ai sống đẹp lòng Ngài.

iQueridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!

El Evangelio de este domingo nos presenta una enseñanza profunda sobre la humildad, un valor central en la vida cristiana. Jesús dice: "*Cuando te inviten, ve a sentarte en el último lugar...*" (Lucas 14,10). En una sociedad que valora los títulos, el estatus y el reconocimiento, Jesús nos propone un camino diferente: el de la sencillez, el servicio, y la confianza en que es Dios quien nos eleva.

La verdadera grandeza, a los ojos de Dios, no se mide por la importancia de nuestro lugar en la mesa, sino por la disposición de nuestro corazón a amar y servir sin esperar recompensa. Jesús mismo, siendo el Señor de todo, escogió el lugar más bajo: lavó los pies de sus discípulos, se sentó con pecadores, y entregó su vida por nosotros. Su ejemplo nos invita a reflexionar: ¿Buscamos ser reconocidos, o buscamos servir?

En nuestra vida diaria—en el hogar, en el trabajo, en la escuela, en la parroquia—tenemos muchas oportunidades de “tomar el último lugar”: dejar que otros vayan primero, escuchar antes que hablar, ayudar sin que nos lo pidan, hacer el bien sin que nadie lo note. Estos gestos humildes construyen el Reino de Dios.

La primera lectura, del libro del Eclesiástico, reafirma esta enseñanza: "*Cuanto más grande seas, más debes humillarte, y así alcanzarás el favor de Dios*" (Eclo 3,18). Cuando reconocemos que todo lo que somos y tenemos es un don de Dios, nos volvemos más agradecidos y generosos.

Pidamos al Señor, esta semana, un corazón humilde: un corazón que ama en silencio, sirve con alegría y da gracias en todo. Así seremos verdaderos discípulos de Cristo, que vino no para ser servido, sino para servir.





KEEPING SUNDAY | ALL DAY

As we take time each week to celebrate the Paschal Mystery in the Eucharist and to rest from the burdens of our daily lives, we remind ourselves that we are made in the image and likeness of God who "rested on the seventh day from all the work he had undertaken" (Gn 2:2).

To celebrate the Lord's Day more fully, consider trying the following:

- Do not use Sunday as your catch-all day for errands and household chores.
- Share a family meal after Mass. Have the whole family join in the preparation and cleanup.
- Go for a walk or bike ride and give thanks to God for the beauty of nature.
- Spend time reading the Bible or a spiritual book.
- Pray the Rosary or the Liturgy of the Hours, alone or with others.
- Visit parishioners and others who are homebound.
- Read Bible stories to your children.
- Turn off your gadgets and enjoy the silence
