Announcements

- Membership Registration for the new season begins September 1st.
- All USA members who are coaches will have access to the Bronze level of the Coaching Education Courses. As an IOWA REGION BENEFIT all of the Region coaches will have access to the Silver level. The coach needs to contact the region office for their discount code.
- All USA Volleyball members have access to the NTDP (National Training Development Program) materials in the USAV Academy.
- REMINDER JUNIOR AGE ASSISTANT COACHES. THE HEAD COACH MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL PRACTICES AND TOURNAMENTS.
- 18 Year Olds in High School can be Head Coaches for teams 14U and Younger. However, a certified adult must be in attendance and on the roster at ALL TEAM EVENTS including but not limited to Meetings, Practices and Matches.
- Teams 15U and younger may take the ref and score modules together. The coach should take the certification online before the team takes it together. Once this is done the coach needs to email a team list to al@iavbreg.org.
- Clubs may hire a qualified clinician to give a ref and score clinic to your club. The clinician must be approved by the region, and it will be the club's responsibility to pay the clinician. All members who attend the clinic will receive credit. You may arrange a clinician through Al Cleary at al@iavbreg.org.
- All referee/scorer certifications have expired, members must take the new modules to be certified. The modules will be available later this fall.







Club Director Membership Requirements

The Club Director must be currently eligible before the Club is activated in the membership system and their information is posted on the region website.

- 1. Current Adult Junior Club Staff Membership (\$60)
- 2. Cleared USAV Background Screening (\$14)
- 3. All Waivers Signed
- 4. Current USOC SafeSport training completed
- Current IMPACT certification

Step One -When to Activate

Clubs need to fill out the activation form each year for the club to be a sanctioned USAV club.

New Clubs should activate as soon as possible after forming.

Any out of region club wishing to become an lowa club must receive permission from their Regional Commissioner.

If you are forming or combining clubs, select a unique name. Name must be approved by the region office.

• The Club 5 digit code will be assigned by the region office to prevent duplication.

Club Types



One-Team Club. These clubs <u>may NOT borrow</u> players from any other club or team.



Multi-Team Club program. For school or groups that have several teams either in the same or different age groups. Advantages:

The teams can share a practice facility, coaches, and share players for tournament teams. (Note you can only play or coach on 1 team per tournament.)

It allows players within the club to progress to a higher classification as their skills improve.



Club with Sub Clubs -Needs to fill out 1 club activation form

Allows players to play on multiple teams between the clubs.

All teams must have the same **5 digit club code** in their team code.

The clubs joining are called "main club" and "sub clubs".

Facility Insurance Form

- A USA Volleyball Club receives insurance coverages for clubs and facilities as part of their membership
 - ► <u>Insurance Request</u> forms to cover clubs and facilities
 - ▶ The insurance certificates for last year's clubs and facilities are emailed after September 1st, when a club has been activated.

Tryout Form

<u>Tryout form should be completed</u> <u>for all tryouts</u> – even if they are a closed tryout (invitation only).

- •Fill out ASAP, or at least 2 weeks before tryout.
- •The form ensures that tryouts are sanctioned and insured.
- •Form may be found on the Region website under the Club Director's Page.

Tryout Rules

- All participants are registered members
- All staff are registered members, background screened & SafeSport certified
- Must use Iowa Region commitment dates when offering bids

- 1. Before participating in any activity (tryout, practice, etc.):
 All participants need to be current (paid).
- 2. All participants must register themselves online.
 This included Players (Parent/Guardian must complete),
 Club Directors, Team Representatives, Coaches,
 Chaperones, Referees, Scorers and Tourney/Site Directors.
 - For Proof have them bring:
 - Their Membership Card can be downloaded to your phone.
 - Or Printed Membership Card.

Waivers

No waivers will be given to teams competing in events that qualify a team for National Competition.

- ▶ 11th grade players who turn 18 during the season are eligible to play on a 17's Age Team.
- ▶ No boys allowed on girls teams trying to qualify for Nationals.

Teams may have waivers for players that do not meet the age requirement as long as they are in the appropriate grade.

▶ Boys may be waivered on to a girl's teams that are 8th grade/14u or younger.

Male Only – Players who were born on or after July 1, who are in the corresponding grade are eligible to play in the 12, 13 and 14 & Under divisions.



Staff Requirements

Coach Requirements

All Requirements must be met before a Coach is placed on the roster.



IMPACT certifications

IMPACT courses are FREE online through the USAV Academy. New Coaches and Club Directors will be automatically enrolled once they have completed membership.



SafeSport certification

Required of all staff before interacting with junior athletes.

SafeSport courses are FREE online through the USAV Academy. Coaches will be automatically enrolled once they have completed membership.



A USAV Background Screening is needed for an adult (18 years old) when they are associated with a junior program or working junior events.

The Screening must be passed and is good for 1 year. You will receive a link in the "Action Items" to pay and complete enrollment.

Junior Aged Assistant Coaches: When a Junior Aged Assistant Coach **becomes 18 years or older,** they need a USAV background screening. Contact Region for help in completing process.

Parent Helper/Chaperone Requirements

A USAV Background Screening

Needed for an adult (18 years old) associated with a junior program or working junior events.

- Valid for 1 year
- Screening process is part of membership registration if you sign up with a staff membership.

SafeSport certification

Is needed for all adult team staff before interacting with junior athletes.

Sign All Waivers

 The Online Membership process populates the waiver, once the adult selects the staff membership, officiating or directing at junior events, Chaperones must be minimum 25 years of age.

Tryout

Club Preparation



Sanction your tryout by filling out the Tryout Sanction Form

inform players if you are looking for all positions or just filling a few positions on an invitation team. How many players per team- maximum, minimum



Post information in club brochure or on website for parents.

Club fees and extras fees (uniforms, post season events) team selection, practice time playing time.

Workers at the tryout need to be:

- Current USAV members.
- Have a current USAV background screening.
- Have a SafeSport certification.

Tryouts

Club Tryout fees should NOT include a membership cost.

Participants should do their memberships online.

 Check membership by viewing membership cards they download or print from the membership system.

Tryout Membership options

- Tryout memberships can be purchased through the region website.
- Tryout Memberships are good for unlimited tryouts

If a Non-USA member is participating in the tryout the facility insurance is no longer in effect.

Participant Membership Info

The Junior Tryout memberships are upgradable

- Upgradable to a Full membership and the fee will be applied to the cost of the full membership.
- Upgrade by renewing your membership from the club link.

Do Not select the **Full Membership** until you are chosen by a club.

• NO refunds of full membership are issued if you do not make a club.

Tryout Dates

1

The Iowa Region supports the IGHSAU and discourages High School tryouts during the season.

2

All offers made at any tryout, early or fall, must be honored until the region commitment dates.

3

Summer Tryouts

• Allowed after the Girls' USAV National Championships.

4

Fall Tryouts

 Players may participate in High School tryouts as determined by their local school board. Please reference their website for any information.

Offers by Clubs

A club or team may offer a player a position in their club or team at anytime.

- Coaches or club directors may NOT ask/force players to give a verbal/written commitment before the Iowa Region commitment dates.
- Limited number of offers
 Clubs should not extend more offers than the number of players accepted for the team
- Offers are on the table until the commitment date or they are refused. Clubs may issue new offers once an offer is refused or expires (commitment date).
- Online Commitment System (OCS) as proof of acceptance
- This is the only valid commitment system in Iowa.
- A Player acceptance by invitation must be followed up in the OCS system.
- All commitments are kept in OCS.
- After January 1st any club assignment in the membership system (SportsEngine) will be considered a commitment to the club.

Offer Periods:

- •Any offer made in either the Early Tryout or Fall Tryout period, <u>must be kept open</u> until the specified commitment dates.
- •A player may commit at any time.
- •After the commitment date the offer may be withdrawn by the club.

This should be communicated before tournament signup but if a situation warrants during the season, the tournament can apply restrictions that could carry over for the rest of the season and future seasons.

Leagues may fill their events to 100% capacity

Gold/Silver level tournaments can only fill their events to 50% capacity
