



Santos Code of Conduct for Adult Players

As a player representing Santos you should always:

- Adhere to the laws of the game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote fair play
- Always respect the match officials decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language and behaviour
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- Respect all coaches, officials and players
- Win or lose with dignity - shake hands with opposition players and officials as well as match officials at the beginning and end of the game

As a player representing Santos if any of the above rules are not adhered to you could be:

- Required to apologise to team mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a warning from your coach / manager
- Receive a written warning from the club committee
- Be required to attend an FA education course
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be required to leave the club

Players should also note that any breach of the above rules could result in Santos being fined and / or suspended by the FA / County FA
