PLEASE NOTE:

Even though the Barber Course (1500 Hour) class takes approximately 10 months to complete, however we allow 12 months to complete.

Please remember that there is a \$25. Fee per day you go over your predetermined class hour requirement graduation date.

How will you finance your tuition?

Our school has not been established long enough to qualify for FAFSA/FSA Federal student aid or VA Funding, rest assure our school has begun the accreditation process and will make this an option as soon as our school has reached this benchmark and will make this available to you as soon as possible so we can better assist our students.

Because of this inhibition, funding for our school has limited options. So here is a few options we can offer at this time.

1. You can take out a personal loan through your financial institution
2. Pay required down payment on your tuition and make monthly payment arrangements that must be paid prior to graduation date.
3. Take a look into these state funded programs that may be able to assist our students. As long as funding is still available, they may be able to pay a portion, if not all of the tuition if qualified.

First Contact Workforce WIOA (Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act)

Who is WIOA?

The WIOA adult education program enhances the quality, productivity, and competitiveness of West Virginia's workforce. Through this program West Virginia can provide workforce preparation, career services, training, and job placement.

All individuals may be considered eligible for services, with priority being given to individuals who are veterans, recipients of public assistance, and other low-income individuals. Priority may also be given to individuals who are basic skills deficient.

Secondly contact Division of Rehabilitation Services – DRS

Who is DRS?

The West Virginia Division of Rehabilitation Services (DRS) supports youth and adults with disabilities (ages 14 and up) on their path to work and live independently.

DRS provides vocational services to help individuals with disabilities prepare for, obtain, retain or advance in employment. Vocational rehabilitation counselors help consumers assess interests and abilities, explore career options and develop plans to reach their unique employment goals. You may be eligible if you have difficulty with learning, hearing, seeing, communicating, participating in physical activities, coping with stress as well as many other qualifying diagnoses. If a disability affects your ability to learn or work, DRS may be able to help.

- Please keep us up to date on what's going on with this process, so we can be sure to put you in a slot for our upcoming class. Sometimes we do not get notified about possible student funding and students may be forced to start in the following class.
- Note applying to help through these programs can take anywhere from 1.5 – 3 months to get funding approval.

After You've figured out the funding, its time to start the enrollment process and take tour our school.

First, you will need to make an appointment with our student registrar. At this appointment you will need to bring original documents and current information so that we can make copies for our records and to get you set up with the Board of Barbers of West Virginia.

Documents to bring to this appointment:

- Current government issued ID
- Social Security card
- Birth certificate
- Highschool diploma, GED, and/or college transcript
- Recent passport style photograph
- Current Certificate of health
- Tuberculosis test results
- Marriage/Name change Certificate (If applicable)

TB Test and Certificate of health must be completed prior to registration.

Once the enrollment process is complete, it's time to pick a start date, mark your calendar and start dreaming big because at new generation barber academy we stive to make your dream a reality.
