Prime Salmon Fishing On The River Tweed

Embark on a journey into the world of salmon fishing on the famous River Tweed. Salmon fishing offers a unique adventure for those seeking both excitement and tranquillity, set against the backdrop of the Tweed's pristine waters.

The River Tweed, with its rich fishing heritage, stands as a testament to extraordinary salmon runs. Its waters host some of the finest fishing opportunities globally, offering the potential for an exceptional catch with each cast. Explore the heritage of the Tweed, where tradition and the excitement of the chase come together for an exceptional salmon fishing experience.

Nestled within the Lower Tweed, you'll discover Upper North Wark, providing nearly a mile of prime river between Coldstream and Kelso. With four distinct pools, including the well-known Snipe Rock pool, Upper North Wark emerges as an ideal destination for your salmon fishing adventure.

Begin your journey into the heart of salmon fishing at Upper North Wark.

Did you know?

The life cycle of the Atlantic Salmon commences in the autumn when the eggs are laid and buried in the gravel at the riverbed, such as in rivers like the Tweed. Come early spring, these eggs hatch into tiny alevins, still reliant on the attached yolk sac for food. They stay underneath the gravel for 4 to 6 weeks because they cannot swim very well, and it also protects them from predators.

In late spring and early summer, the alevins evolve into fry, emerging from the stones to feed on water organisms. By their first year, fry transition into parr, feeding on insects and residing in freshwater for a period ranging from 1 to 4 years. Subsequently, they become smolts. The smolts undergo migration to the sea in their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year, embarking on a journey where they cover substantial distances and feed on sandeels, krill, and herring.

Following 1 to 4 years at sea, the mature salmon embark on a return journey to the river of their birth for breeding. Remarkably, they do not eat upon reentering the river. Salmon that return after only one year at sea are called "grilse." The breeding process, known as spawning, involves the female using her tail to create a redd or small nest in the gravel. She then lays her eggs, and the male salmon releases milt to fertilize them. Post-spawning, the majority of salmon perish, but certain females, referred to as kelts, return to the sea to spawn again in the subsequent year.



What to expect

Whether you're a novice eager to learn or an experienced angler seeking a new adventure, our beat offers a variety of options to make your day on the River Tweed unforgettable.

Upon arrival, our experienced ghillies will warmly welcome you to the beat, providing a brief overview of the day ahead. Feel free to bring your own equipment or explore our top-end offerings, such as the Loop brand, available for hire. Whether you're a seasoned angler or a novice, our ghillies are here to guide you through the exciting world of salmon fishing.

The day typically starts at 9.00am when you will climb into your boots and waders and be taken to explore the pools of the beat. With a one-hour lunch break at 1pm, you can relax and recharge before resuming your fishing adventure. Rods often rotate pools throughout the day, allowing you to experience the full beauty of the beat.

Our beat boasts five wooden Tweed boats, allowing you the best access to all the pools. These will be rowed by our skilled ghillies, providing a unique perspective on the river. In certain conditions, you may also enjoy wading through parts of the beat, adding another dimension to your fishing experience.

For those seeking a truly deluxe experience, our Deluxe Salmon Fishing

Experience offers personalized tuition, full equipment inclusion, and deluxe amenities. You can even enjoy a gourmet lunch and toast the river with a drop of sloe gin or a "wee dram".









The Pools

The pools are where the salmon rest on their journey up the river. There is a variety of water over the 4 named pools - Snipe, Mill Stream, Back Of The Isle and Wark Dub. In recent years, more of the Mill Stream has been opened up and this has allowed access to parts of the beat not previously fished. There has been a noticeable increase in the catches in these new areas.

When fishing in higher water, sinking lines tend to be used with assorted poly leaders to cover the variations in the pools.

The Hut

The beat has ample off road parking and a well-appointed fishers' hut with heating, cooking and toilet facilities available for your use. The hut is situated at the centre of the beat and all pools are easily accessed. During 2019 a new fishing hut was built which has improved the facilities on the beat to an exceptional level.

Accommodation

We can make recommendations for local hotels but they tend to get booked up at peak fishing times – so early booking is recommended.

We can collect you from your accommodation and drop you back if you are staying within 10 miles of the beat at no extra charge. If you are staying outside this range or want a lift from airports and train stations we can normally arrange this – but there will be an additional charge.

The Ghillies


Upper North Wark is a three rod beat, but we can extend this to four rods on request by a single party booking depending on the river levels.

Our expert Head Ghillie - Martin Ritchie - will be on hand to guide you throughout your day, assisted by full time underghillie Jamie. They are long standing Tweed boatmen and will enhance your enjoyment of the day. They will offer advice on the best flies to use and where the salmon may be lying. This service is included in all of our packages. On certain packages they can offer casting tuition and row the boats to access the pools.



Experienced Angler Package

For Expert Anglers and experienced fisherman.

Traditionally labelled a beat requiring higher water levels, Upper North Wark has undergone a transformation under new ownership. Extensive weed clearance and bank management have improved water flows across the beat, making available access to the once inaccessible "islands" section. This waded area, mainly along a shingle river bed, has become a comfortable wade, producing fish all year round, particularly during salmon runs.

A new pool at the bottom of the dub, bordering Lower North Wark, adds another dimension to the fishing experience. While wading is possible, caution is advised in this pool when water levels exceed 2 feet. Despite being a recent development, catches have already been recorded, marking a promising addition to the beat.


The wet summer of 2023 boosted catches in July and August. Sea trout can also offer good sport at this time of year.

Considering the river's width at 135 yards at its maximum point, water flow may decrease in very low water conditions. Our two full-time ghillies, using double-handed rods, will row you throughout the beat, adopting a "left hand up" fly fishing approach from the boats.

For optimal fishing at good water levels, we primarily use fully sinking lines with tips and tubes. When the water is at 1ft, an intermediate line with a fast tip proves effective.

Spinning is permitted from February 15th to September 14th, featuring options like the Devon Minnow and Toby in the early season. The "Rap n Burrly" has success as the water warms up.

Our Head Ghillie – ties his own flies and will advise on the best options for the prevailing conditions.

Meet in the fishing hut at 8.45am for a coffee and pastry. Toast the river with a drop of sloe gin and / or a "wee dram".



The head Ghillie Martin Ritchie will explain the day ahead, fishing prospects and what you can expect from the day.



We then climb into our waders and boots and start the initial casting lessons on the riverbank.



Once you have gained confidence, a ghillie will row you down the river where we think (hope!) the salmon may be laying.



Stop for lunch where a barbecue lunch will be served by a local restaurant and will be accompanied by beers, wine etc.



Fishing resumes at 2.00pm and will be a combination of bank, boat and wading in the river – subject to river heights.



Fish through to 5.00pm and conclude with a beer / cup of tea and review the day.


MAKE A BOOKING

NB. There is no guarantee of catching a fish and any salmon caught before 1st July need to be returned to the water by order of the Tweed Commissioners. Weather conditions may mean that fishing cannot occur – invariably for the safety of the rods and the ghillies. The Head Ghillie's decision will be final in such matters and no refund can be offered if fishing does not take place.
