Holy Week and Easter

Holy Week and Easter is a very busy time for Moravians. After all we are known as “The Easter People”!

Palm Sunday: We begin with our Palm Sunday celebration which features our children leading us in singing the Hosanna during worship.

Holy Week Readings: On March 30, 31 and April 1, we have our Holy Week Reading Services at 6:30 pm in the sanctuary. We gather during these three days to read aloud the gospel stories of Jesus’s last week, from Palm Sunday to the Crucifixion. This is a unique and meaningful way to focus ourselves spiritually in preparation for Easter. If you have never attended, please consider joining us.

Maundy Thursday April 1: At 6:30m pm we gather in the sanctuary to share in Holy Communion and remember the last supper and the importance of this sacrament in our lives.

Good Friday Tenebrae April 2: On Friday at 6:30 pm we remember Jesus’s crucifixion and death with the service of shadows based on his final words. We also have an opportunity to consider our sins and nail them to the cross.

Sunrise Service at Shiloh, Easter Sunday morning at 6 am. We gather at the Shiloh Moravian Church (2468 Shiloh Road, Sturgeon Bay) and proclaim, “The Lord is Risen Indeed”. Within this service is the most profound confession of our Moravian faith. We begin in the church and then move outside as the sun rises, the brass band plays, and the sandhill cranes and wood ducks proclaim the tomb is empty. Come early if you want a seat, this is a very popular service!

Easter Breakfast: At 9 am we gather in the church dining room to eat a fabulous Easter breakfast which includes “Sugar Cake”! There is a freewill offering collected to support our youth who serve the meal.

Candy Hunt: At 9:30 am we have a Easter candy hunt for the children.

Easter Morning Worship: At 10:30 am we conclude with our full morning worship service which is meant to inspire and empower us to live as Resurrection People!
