GROWING IN GOD'S GRACE

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

A little boy was sitting in church, listening to the Gospel about Jesus sending out His disciples. After Mass, he asked his mother, "Mom, why does Jesus keep saying there are not enough workers?" His mother smiled and said, "Because there are so many people who need to hear about God's love."

The boy thought for a moment and replied, "Then why doesn't He just hire more people?"

Sometimes we smile at a child's simple logic, but perhaps the boy was asking a question many of us quietly ask. Why doesn't God do everything Himself? Why does He need us?

In today's Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds and is moved with compassion because they are like sheep without a shepherd. His heart aches for people who are lost, wounded, lonely, and searching for hope.

But then Jesus does something surprising. Instead of doing everything Himself, He turns to His disciples and sends them out. He makes them part of His mission.

The harvest is abundant. The needs are great. Yet God's plan has always been to work through ordinary people. Fishermen, tax collectors, parents, teachers, grandparents, students—people just like us.

The call of discipleship begins not with extraordinary abilities but with a heart that has encountered the compassion of Christ. Before we can bring His love to others, we must first allow Him to love us.

Jesus tells His disciples, "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Everything we have is a gift. Our faith is a gift. God's mercy is a gift. His forgiveness is a gift. We have received freely, and so we are called to give freely.

Many people think they are not qualified to be missionaries. They imagine that evangelization is only for priests, religious sisters, or professional speakers. Yet the most effective witnesses are often ordinary Christians who simply reflect the love of Jesus in daily life.

A smile to a stranger. A visit to someone who is sick. A phone call to a lonely person. A word of encouragement to someone who is struggling. These simple acts may seem small, but they can reveal the compassionate heart of Christ.

The world today is still filled with people who are searching for a shepherd. Jesus continues to look upon them with compassion. And He continues to send us.

Perhaps the little boy was right in one sense. Jesus is still "hiring." The difference is that He does not offer a paycheck. Instead, He offers something far greater—the joy of sharing in His mission and the privilege of helping others discover His love.

Today, let us ask the Lord to give us His eyes, His heart, and His compassion. May we become laborers in His harvest, bringing His peace and mercy to everyone we meet.

For the heart that has truly encountered Jesus cannot keep His love to itself.

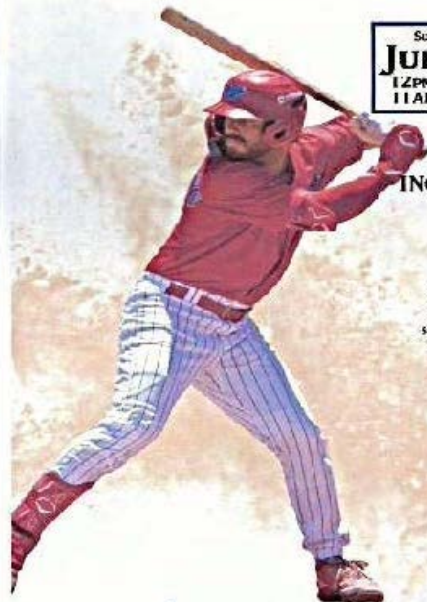
