CONFIRMATIONS 2025: Bishop Marcus will confer the sacrament of Confirmation in our Deanery on the 25th of November with the venue to be confirmed. As usual preparation for the sacrament for year 6 children will take place in our schools. BAPTISM PREPARATION: The next baptism preparation session will take place on the 23rd of August at 2.00pm at St Urban's. Please remember that booking a baptism cannot be happen without first attending a preparation session.
