### **ROLE**

- o Reports to Officer of the Day (OOD)
- Responsible for deploying and retrieving race marks

# **REQUIRED**

- Ability to lift heavy objects
- o Able to take weather observations to relay to Race Officer
- o Ability to use and understand a GPS
- o Understanding of sailing and courses
- o Ochre Card
- o Australian Sailing Powerboat Handling Certificate

#### **DESIRED**

- o Relevant experience on water
- o Understanding of courses relevant to the event or racing

### **PREPARATION**

- o Sign in on the volunteer register in the Tower
- Attend the Volunteer briefing
- o Collect required equipment PFD & keys
- o Ensure you have a mobile phone with the BUOYZONE APP downloaded
- o Check correct marks, weights and anchors are in the boat before launching
- o Ensure all marks are adequately inflated

## **DUTIES**

- o Perform mark boat start up procedure, complete radio checks with the Tower before launching
- o Following the Race Officer's directions, set up the racecourse by deploying marks based on the provided course in BUOYZONE
- o At the completion of racing, retrieve marks and return to shore
- o Wash down and pack away equipment, return PFD, keys to Tower
- o Report any issues or defects
- o Sign off on the volunteer register in the Tower

NOTE – the skipper has the responsibility for the safety of their crew and vessel
