



RESCUE BOAT

ROLE

- Reports to the Officer of the Day (OOD)
- Responsible for driving a DSC rescue boat during racing to monitor boats around the racecourse
- Attend to boats that require assistance & tow as required

REQUIRED

- Australian Sailing Powerboat Handling Certificate
- Ochre Card

DESIRED

- Australian Sailing Safety Boat Operators Certificate
- Marine Radio Operators Certificate of Proficiency
- First Aid Certification

PREPARATION

- Sign in on the volunteer register in the Tower
- Attend Volunteer briefing
- Perform boat start up procedure, complete radio checks with the Tower before launching
- Familiarize yourself and crew members with the location of your safety equipment
- Ensure safety systems are in proper working condition
- Collect required equipment from the Tower – PFD & keys

DUTIES

- Monitor the fleet of competitors on the racecourse
- Perform safety duties and retrievals as required
- Assist with race management duties as directed
- Wash down and pack away equipment, return PFD, keys to Tower
- Report any issues or defects
- Sign off on the volunteer register in the Tower

NOTE – the skipper has the responsibility for the safety of their crew and vessel
