## **ROLE**

- o Reports to the Officer of the Day (OOD)
- o Responsible for driving a DSC rescue boat during racing to monitor boats around the racecourse
- o Attend to boats that require assistance & tow as required

# **REQUIRED**

- o Australian Sailing Powerboat Handling Certificate
- o Ochre Card

### **DESIRED**

- o Australian Sailing Safety Boat Operators Certificate
- o Marine Radio Operators Certificate of Proficiency
- o First Aid Certification

#### **PREPARATION**

- o Sign in on the volunteer register in the Tower
- Attend Volunteer briefing
- o Perform boat start up procedure, complete radio checks with the Tower before launching
- o Familiarize yourself and crew members with the location of your safety equipment
- o Ensure safety systems are in proper working condition
- o Collect required equipment from the Tower PFD & keys

#### **DUTIES**

- o Monitor the fleet of competitors on the racecourse
- o Perform safety duties and retrievals as required
- o Assist with race management duties as directed
- o Wash down and pack away equipment, return PFD, keys to Tower
- o Report any issues or defects
- o Sign off on the volunteer register in the Tower

NOTE – the skipper has the responsibility for the safety of their crew and vessel
