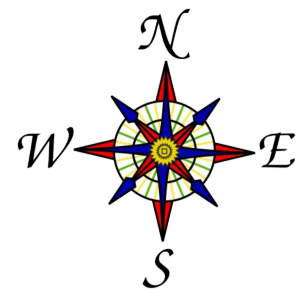
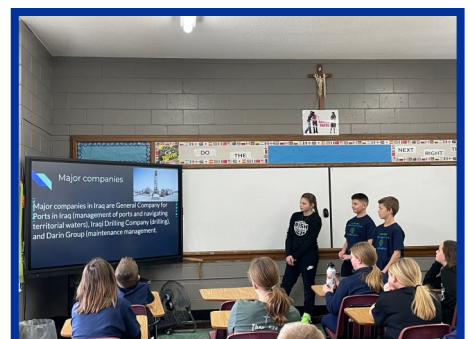
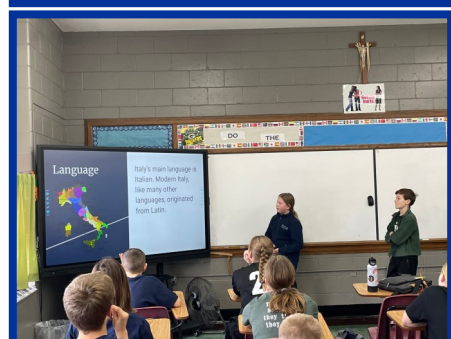
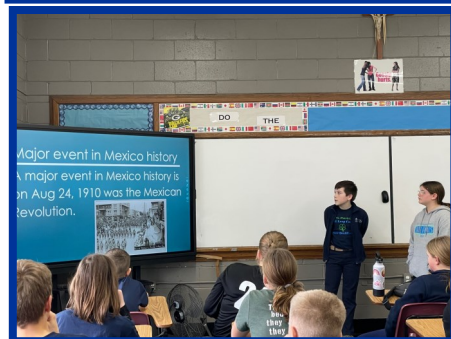
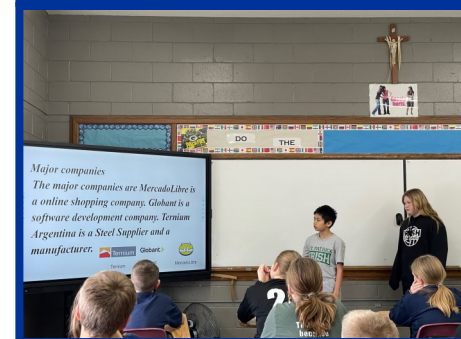
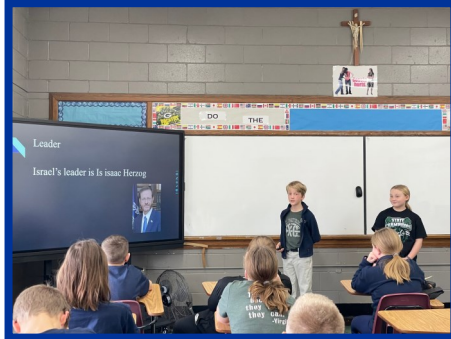
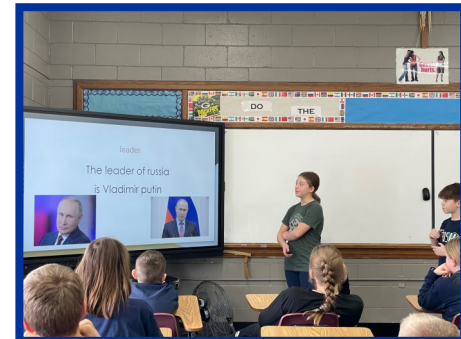
5th—8th Grade helped the Park District this week. Students filled hundreds of Easter eggs so the Park District will be ready for their Easter egg hunt this Spring.

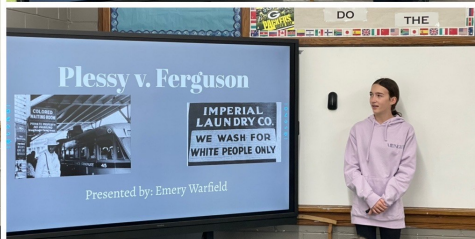
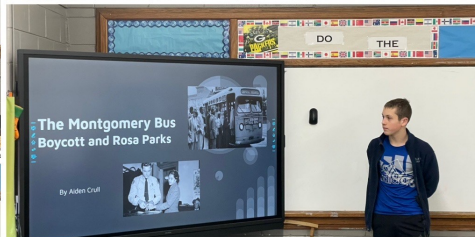
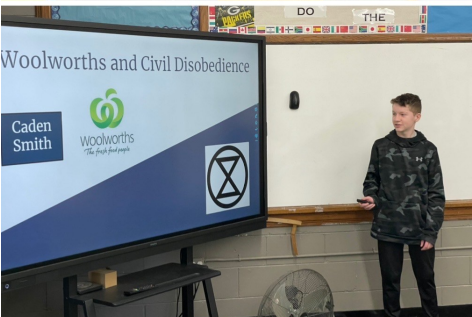
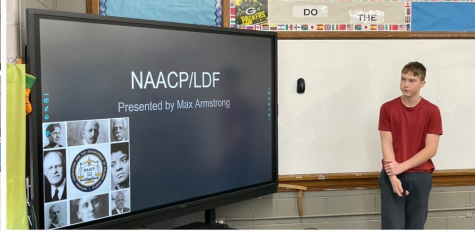
5th Grade Social Studies prepared and presented information about a country of their choosing.

It had to be a country we had covered this year in geography. They researched information on government, life expectancy, major imports, and various other topics about their country. They then created a slideshow and shared it with the class.



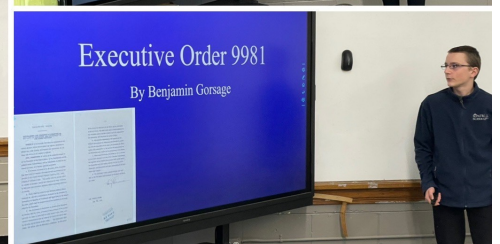
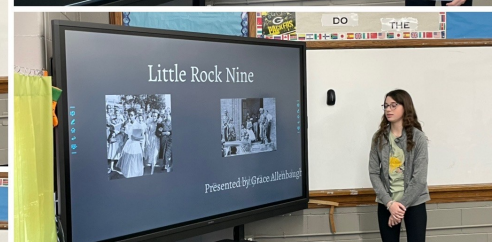
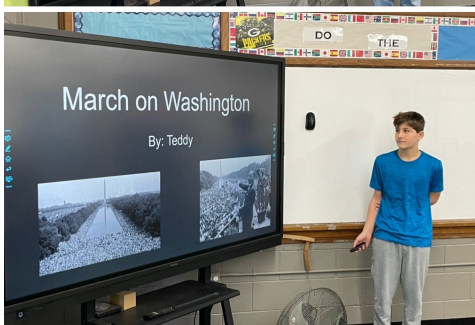
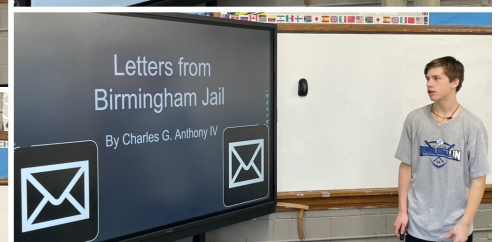
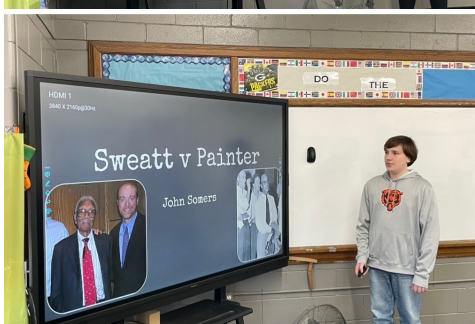
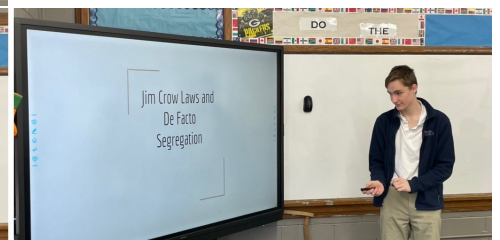
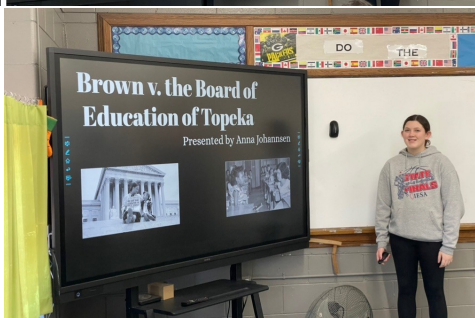
Civil Rights Presentations

The 8th grade created slides on Civil Rights leaders, court cases, and major events. They researched their topics and shared a brief presentation with the class.



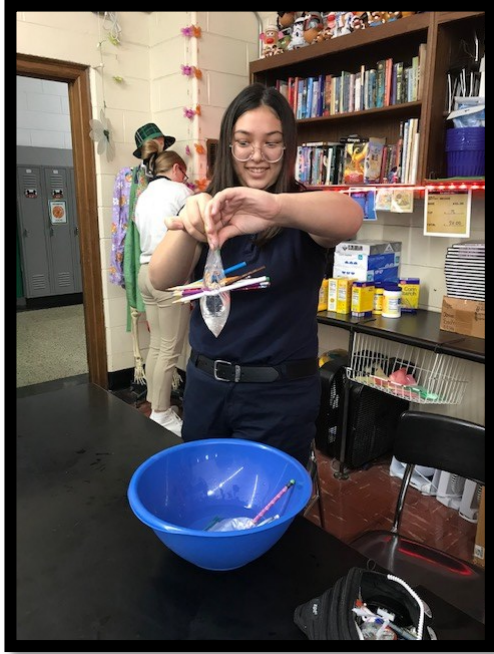

7th grade physics class have fun doing water pressure experiments.

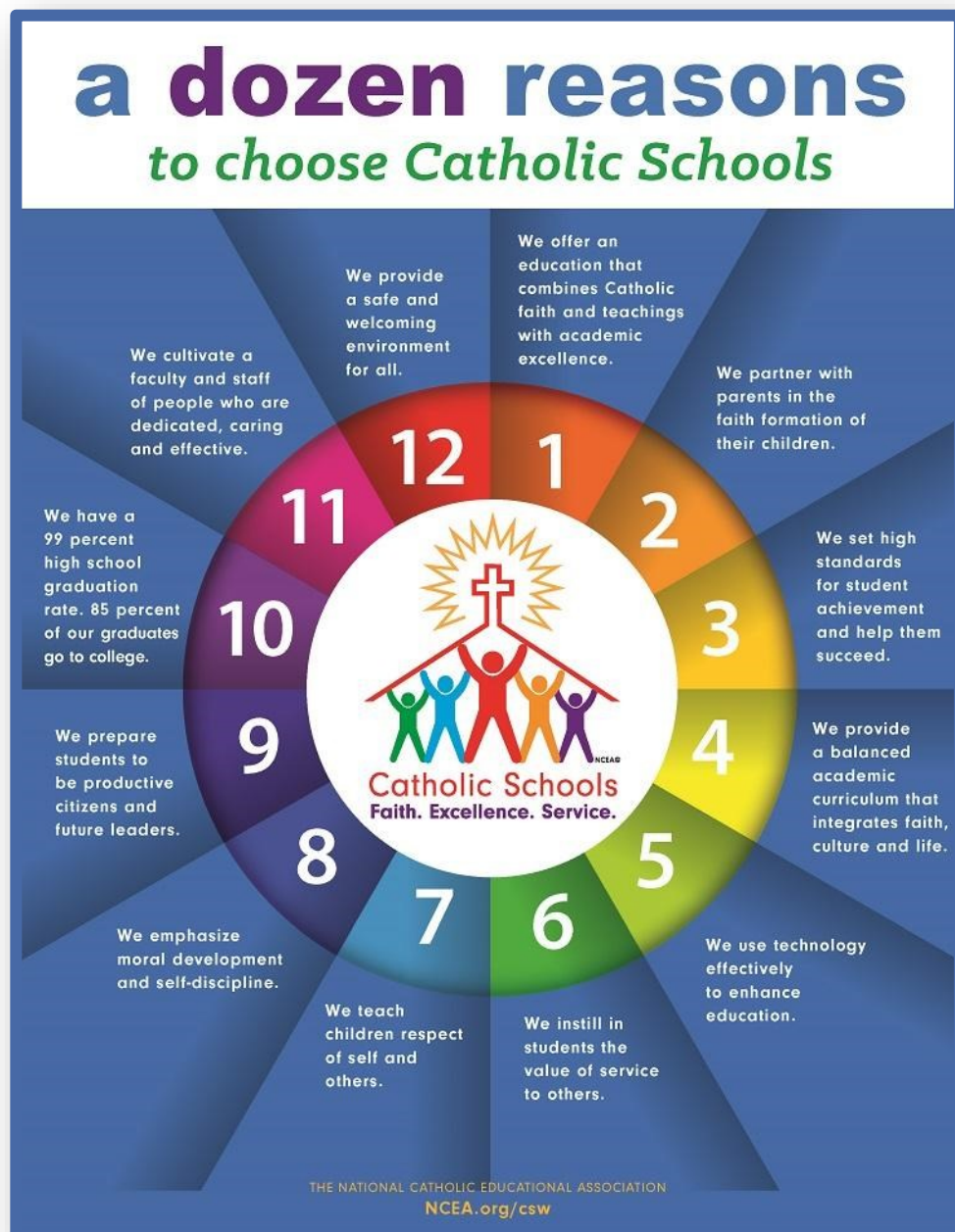


8th grade chemistry class made oobleck while studying hydrocarbons and polymers.

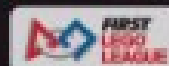

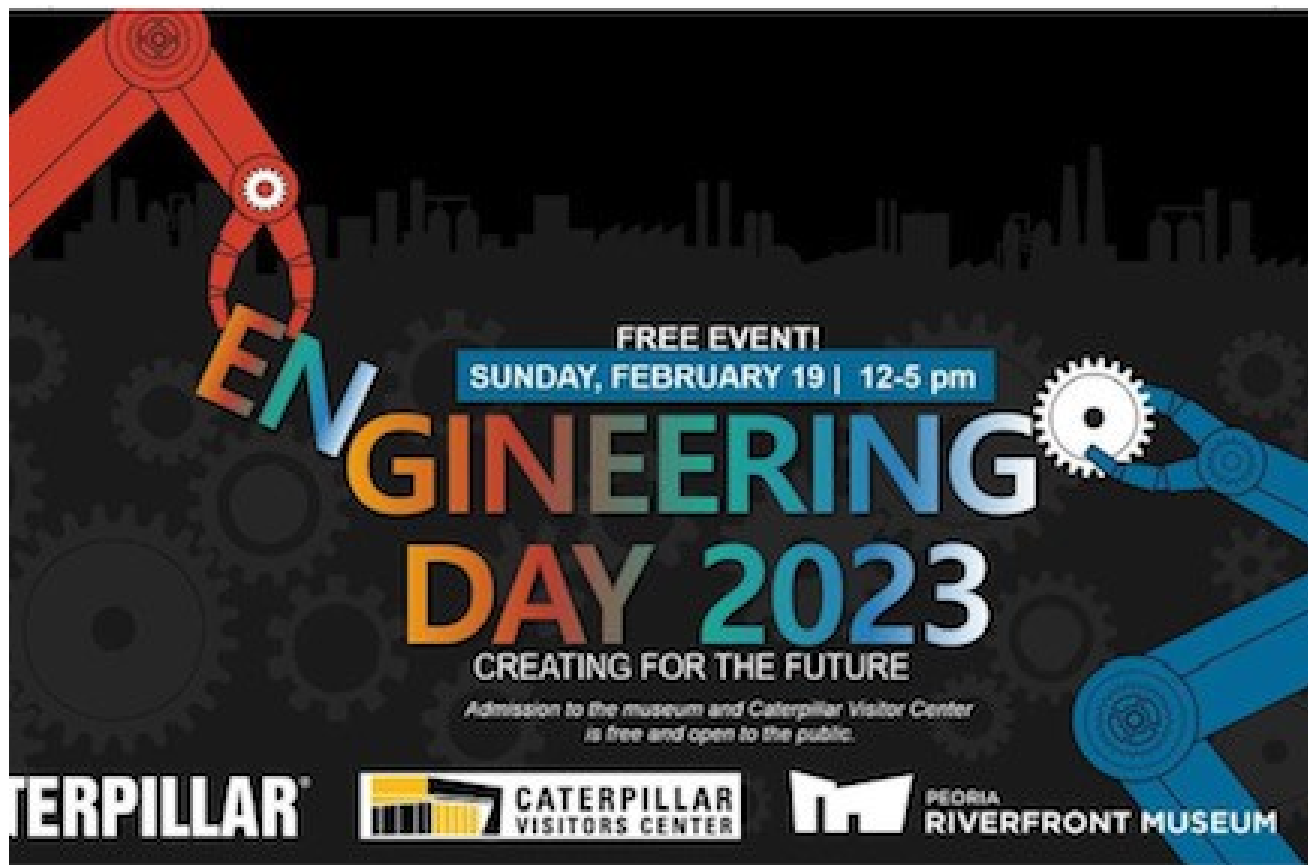
