St. Patrick School Finishes in Top Ten of Catholic Math League


(Washington, III.) St. Patrick School's eighth grade math students finished among the top ten schools in the national Catholic Math League Competition for pre-algebra. In a competition that included 61 schools from throughout the country, St. Patrick students finished in 9th place in their first year participating in this competition.

The competition consists of four rounds of timed tests with each test composed of 25 challenging questions. The use of calculators is not allowed during the tests.


A total of nine St. Patrick students participated in the competition that included more than 830 students. The top scorer for St. Patrick was Max Armstrong who finished in 20 th place, followed by Ben Gorsage in 44 th place and Eian Doty in 48 th place. Other members of the team in-

cluded Grace Allenbaugh, Aiden Crull, Anna Johannsen, Teddy Showalter, Caden Smith, and McKenna Sparks. All nine members of the team placed in the top half of the field.

The top three finishers from each school will be recognized with certificates issued by the competition staff.
