Did you spot who else had fun Field Day? Mr. Jones and Mrs. Biagini had to try out some of the games too!



Congratulations to the 2023 DARE Essay Winners from St. Patrick School!




Please also congratulate the 5th and 6th graders who participated in DARE this year.

The Third Graders did a Bible Sharing in Religion Class with Sr. Gemma for their closing activity. It was an awesome experience for all of them.












Bus Driver Position

In-Person Learning Only: St. Patrick School will be offering In-Person Learning only for the 2023-2024 school year. There will be no options offered for semester or full year remote learning for 2023-2024 school year.

<u>Vacations:</u> Please <u>schedule vacations during school breaks and long weekends</u> rather than during student attendance days.

Taking vacations outside of school breaks is extremely disruptive to the learning environment. Students, families, faculty, and staff taking vacations are subject to current regulations from CDC, IDPH, OCS, and ISBE directives regarding returning to in-school classes.
