


AP classes in AP French, German,

What would be your disguise if you were a Thanksgiving Turkey? Here are a couple suggestions from the 5th grade students.














Today, the 8th graders helped Mr. Mickels set up the church nativity scene!

Dear Parishioners and School Families, and Friends:

St. Patrick School continues to participate in the Catholic virtue-based program called "SportsLeader Ministry". We have been in this program since 2017. The virtue program has four pillars: Virtue, Mentoring, Ceremony, and Catholic Identity. The program is designed for schools and teams who want a structured, intentional, specific curriculum and method to help teach virtue. Each athletic program has activities and ceremonies the athletes participate in such as Father/Daughter Jersey Night and Letters to Mom. Teams start and end practices with prayer, often times go to a Mass together or Adoration and participate in service. The virtue program has been extended to all students in the school. Each week the students learn about a new virtue and a prayer that goes with it. This is part of the daily announcements. Teachers receive a communication each week that includes stories, videos, and quotes about the virtue for the week. 

Where: Washington High School

What to wear: An outfit that allows easy mobility

The Performance:

When: Friday, December 16th Times: Arrive at 5:45pm

(The performance will be on the basketball court. It will

take place between the Freshmen Basketball Game and the Varsity Basketball Game—approximately

sometime between 6:30 and 7:15pm.)

Where to drop off: Washington High School multi-purpose room

(The clinic dancers will walk to the gymnasium with the Pantherettes.)

Where to pick up: The West Gym of the High school

(Young dancers will not be permitted to leave unless there is a parent present to pick them up.)

What to Wear: An outfit that allows easy mobility

(Upon arrival on the performance date, girls will receive their clinic T-shirts to wear during the

performance.)

<u>The Price</u>: \$30 (This price includes 2.5 hours of dance training + choreography, a T-shirt designed by the Pantherettes, a snack, a group picture, and 2 tickets for the game)

Additional Information:

- A snack will be provided mid-session, but dancers may want to bring water bottles labeled with their names. Also
 if clinic dancers have a food allergy, please be sure to include that information in your sign-up.
- If parents would like to see a sample of what the dancers will perform, you may come to the Torry Gym at
 Washington High School at 4:00 pm. After all performances, at approximately 4:20 pm, dancers will be
 dismissed for pick-up.
- Clinic T-shirts can be picked up upon arrival at the performance.
- If you are unable to make the performance, clinic T-shirts can be picked up from the front office of the high school beginning Monday, December 19th.
