


- ***June 6- remaining clothing and camp bills due (TBD)
- *** There will be practice and conditioning throughout the summer. While summer practice is flexible, you are strongly encouraged to attend as much as you can.
- ***Kids camp - June 6-9. 7:00-10:15AM. Attendance is mandatory.
- ***July 17-20: UCA camp at Chula Vista Resort, Wisconsin Dells. Attendance is mandatory
- ***Official mandatory practice/mass for the fall season begins Sunday, August 7.

April 27- Girls will be judged on jumps, tumbling, stunts (Varsity only)

April 28- Girls will be judged on cheer, sideline, and dance

Tryouts skills to be judged:Cheer, Side Line, Dance,Toe Touch,Hurdler,Tumbling (tumbling is not mandatory, but will affect your score)

W and Th- solid white T-shirt, solid navy or black shorts, and shoes
