

MOTION AND RESOLUTION ADOPTING

2025-2026 TAX RATE FOR GCESD #3

WHEREAS, On September 15, 2025, the Board of the Gregg County Emergency Services District #3 ("GCESD # 3") met during a properly noticed special meeting.

WHEREAS, The Board previously voted to propose a tax rate of \$0.08026 per \$100 for the 2025-2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the adoption of the proposed tax rate.

Darby stated, "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.08026 per \$100, which is effectively a 3.9% percent increase in the tax rate."

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the tax rate for the 2025-2026 fiscal year for GCESD #3 shall be \$0.08026 per \$100 valuation.

"THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.9% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$3.04."
