For urgent queries about people who have arrived in Tasmania from high risk areas or premises, contact the Public Health Hotline on 1800 671 738 and ask for the COVID Clinical Nurse Consultant on-call.

Testing

- In the current national and Tasmanian circumstances, it is very important to continue to test or refer for testing anyone who presents with symptoms of COVID-19, however mild.
- An online form to register for a COVID-19 test is now available for people needing to register for a COVID-19 test in the North and South of the state.
- To register online, people who need to book a COVID test need go to
 https://covidtestbooking.health.tas.gov.au/ and complete the registration form. A staff member from the
 Department of Health will call back to book an appointment time for a COVID test.

Check in Tas

- From 31 July 2021, the number of businesses and venues requiring people to use Check in TAS will be expanding.
- Anyone aged 16 years or older entering medical and health related venues including residential aged care facilities, doctors surgeries, specialist clinics such as podiatrists, dentists, orthodontists, optometrists, chiropractors etc. will be required to use the Check in TAS app.
- This includes all staff (at the beginning of every shift), volunteers, contractors and patients.
