

Induced abortion statistics have been prepared in Ohio since 1976. The 2023 Annual Abortion Report presents information derived from both the "Confidential Abortion Reports" and "Post-Abortion Care Reports for Complications" in Ohio; reporting forms are included as Appendices I and II. Readers should note that abortion statistics in this report are limited to terminations occurring in Ohio; they do not include Ohio residents who obtained abortions outside the state.

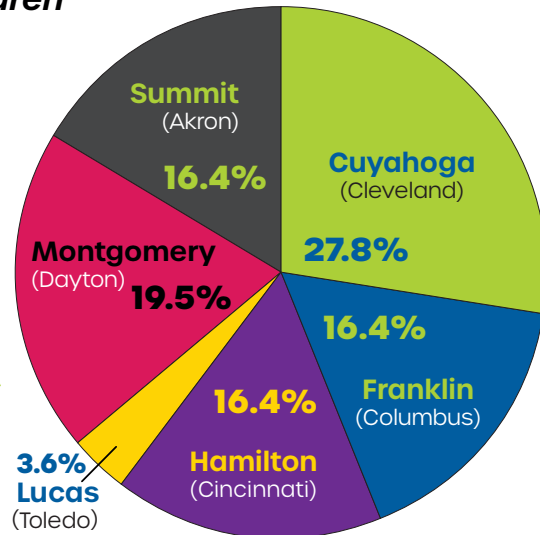

Statewide Characteristics of Ohio Women Who Have Abortions

- **87.4%** are *residents* of *Ohio*
- **42.7%** identify as *white*
- **49.8%** identify as *black*
- **62.3%** have *other children*
- **87.4%** of *women* identify as *single, divorced, or widowed*
- **87.6%** were *12 weeks gestation* or *earlier*
