


In the Gospel this weekend Jesus, our greatest teacher, says something that does not seem "Jesus-like" because it is unsettling. He says: "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." He then proceeds to predict how even families will be divided. Division happens. We all have to make our own decisions about our beliefs and values and we cannot control people. We can understand Jesus' point easily. Many of us have some "family division," whether it be religious, political, financial or just plain personal. Conflict and division are not always avoidable.

It simply takes a little reflection to understand what

Jesus meant. People began to choose sides whether to follow him or to forget about him. There were those who

were quick to believe in Jesus; and those who gradually grew to believe; and those who refused to believe in him. Jesus taught (and proved) that he was fulfillment of all Law and Prophesy. Those who refused to believe in his words and in his works were quite simply the "hard of heart" (eventually they would have to learn the Lord's truth "the hard way"). Everyone was going to have to take a position and answer the question Jesus once asked Peter, "Who do you say that I am?"

Sometimes young adults, growing in their independence, have to make tough decisions about their personal and Catholic lifestyles. Trying out new experiences with new people in a new setting is normal; but our moral compass will always remind us of when it's time to be especially careful and to "think twice" about what we do. Some choose to say "no" to destructive behaviors. This is part of what Jesus



was talking about. You cannot please everyone, not even he could. "Just because everyone else is doing it doesn't make it right", we've heard before. Sometimes we choose Jesus' standards over what others ask us to do (and, in the end, we are grateful for our choice). Our true friends understand. For anyone leaving home this weekend and for everyone entering into new experiences, may your Guardian Angel go with you and may you always bring the best of your faith and your home parish wherever you go!
