Lent is the **liturgical season** marked by the Church in preparation for **Easter**. It emphasizes the practice of **prayer, almsgiving, and fasting**, along with meditation on the Word of God, **conversion**, and reconciliation.

## 4 keys



It begins **Ash Wednesday** and ends the afternoon of **Holy Thursday**.



On **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**, **fasting** and **abstinence** are practiced.




The three **Lenten practices** are **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving**.

## **I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.**

Do I give God time every day in prayer? Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart? Do I seek to surrender myself to God's word as taught by the Church? Have I ever received communion in the state of mortal sin? Have I ever withheld a mortal sin from the priest in Confession? Are there other "gods" in my life? Money, security, power, people, etc.?

## **You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.**

Have I used God's name in vain: lightly or carelessly? Have I been angry with God? Have I wished evil upon any other person?

## **Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.**

Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation? Have I tried to observe Sunday as a family day and a day of rest? Do I do needless work on Sunday?

## **Honor your father and your mother.**

Do I honor and obey my parents? Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children? Have I given my family good religious example? Do I try to bring peace into my home life? Do I care for my aged and infirm relatives?

## **You shall not kill.**

Have I physically harmed anyone? Have I abused alcohol or drugs? Did I give scandal to anyone, thereby leading him or her into sin? Have I been angry or resentful? Have I harbored hatred in my heart? Have I mutilated myself through any form of sterilization? Have I participated in abortion?

## **You shall not commit adultery.**

Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action? Have I engaged in any sexual activity outside of marriage? Have I used any method of contraception or artificial birth control in my marriage? Have I been guilty of the use of pornography and self-abuse? Do I seek to be chaste in my thoughts, words, actions?

## **You shall not steal.**

Have I stolen? Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen? Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs? Do I seek to share what I have with the poor? Have I cheated anyone?

## **You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.**

Have I lied? Have I gossiped? Do I speak badly of others behind their back? Am I critical, negative or uncharitable in my thoughts of others? Have I injured the reputation of others by slanders?

## **You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.**

Have I consented to impure thoughts? Have I caused them by impure reading, movies, television, conversation or curiosity? Have I behaved in an inappropriate and offensive ways?

## **You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.**

Am I jealous of what other people have? Do I envy the families or possessions of others? Am I greedy or selfish? Are material possessions the purpose of my life?


