

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Hello Friends,

While much has changed in college sports, some things remain the same. Even though some (not all) of the student athletes in recent years have received financial compensation and even extra years of eligibility (particularly due to the COVID time), they are still very young adults, 18-23. And with that, they are not perfect and they are still growing up before everyone's eyes.

This Monday will be the National Championship between the #1 team in the nation, the Indiana Hoosiers




(most of us never would have thought Indiana football would rise to such heights), and the determined Miami Hurricanes. As mentioned a few weeks ago in a homily, family and faith plays a big role in the life of the most well-known player on the field, Fernando Mendoza. His mother, Elsa, was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis many years ago. She was also an accomplished college athlete (tennis), but now she is confined to a wheelchair and she can no longer fully raise her arms to hug her family. This family, like many, are tight. They celebrate their victories and achievements and when hardship

comes, they strive to move forward living life to the best of their ability. As fast paced as life can be, they are not afraid to slow down to take care of each other, especially Mom.

Fernando (I am not trying to convert anyone to be a Hoosier—I'll always be a Wolverine) is open about where he finds his extra strength: it comes from his faith. Many Catholic chaplains, priests and Newman Centers (Catholic college organizations) have been seeing in recent years an increase in student participation. Mendoza—rich, successful, and a celebrity—is also still a college student, and he attends Mass just like the others. The increase in collegian participation is also characterized by an increase in personal prayer, devotions, small group faith sharing, and finding meaningful life answers and God's truth. While it is still the case that some young Catholics "drop-off", many become more intentional with their faith. Also, conversions are on the rise. Locally, we are inspired by our college age parishioners who are not only doing their best to be good people, but they are also taking active roles with their faith on campus. (There is a powerful Putnam County Bible Study group being led by Big Green superstars at the University of Cincinnati!) And, also, many know (through Catholic media) that thousands of collegians and other young adults gathered in Columbus earlier this month for the SEEK Conference. The Catholic Church in the U.S. does have a strong future that will be led by these devout and fervent young men and women. We keep praying that such faith grows and makes a positive difference.

And lastly (and somewhat randomly), there was a recent notable passing in the world of music and entertainment, Mr. Bob Weir of the Grateful Dead. Bob (rhythm guitarist) was a co-founder of this iconic band when he was just 17! "Deadheads" (their followers) are a devoted and diverse group, and the band gave them happy memories, they mourn his loss. Something unique about Bob: he was open about the fact that he was adopted. His father, of all things, was a high-ranking military officer! Later in life, they became good friends (see pic), and Bob would later say, "He's Dad." Just goes to show, you never know about how things work out (an establishment father and a "counter-culture" son). About life, Bob would probably say: "*What a long, strange trip it's been*". —Fr. In October, the HVAC system was installed in the Parish Center.


