

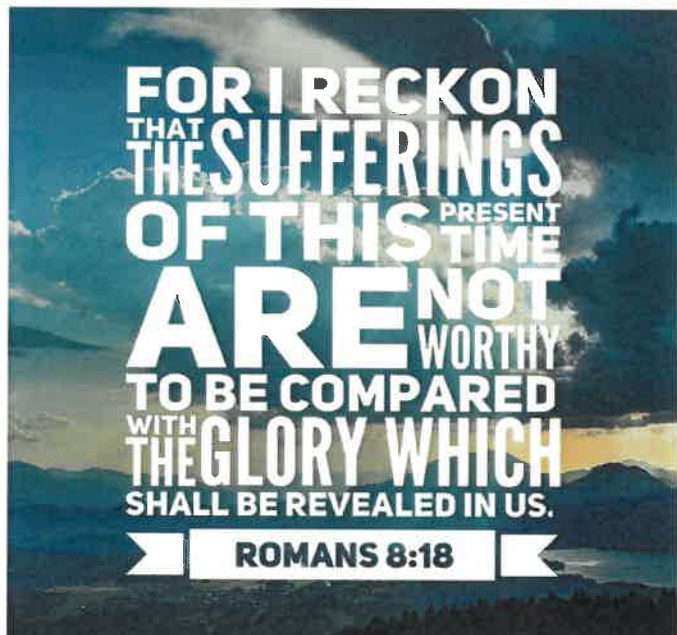

## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Hello Friends,

Thank you for the prayers for safe travels! I'm grateful for the opportunity to spend time with my family. I hope that you too enjoy some quality time with family and friends during these summer weeks.

This Sunday we will all have the special opportunity to gather and support our annual St. Barbara Parish Festival and Social! Thank you to our leaders and the parish volunteers for making this annual church and community event happen! It's a great way to honor the past and look forward to the future.

This Fall (if you follow Catholic media) you will notice a Catholic story coming from southeast Georgia. Where my family lives there is a small town called Darien, GA., home of the Georgia Martyrs.

On October 31, in the Diocese of Savannah, the Georgia Martyrs will be beatified. This is certainly not something that happens very often in our country, so it is very exciting. (But this will be the second major beatification this year following the upcoming beatification of Bishop Fulton Sheen).



The Georgia Martyrs were five Franciscan Friars from Spain who were martyred because of their orthodox stand on the Church's teaching on marriage. One of the martyrs Pedro de Corpa, did not support a rising (Guale Tribe) chief's desire to add another wife to his household (which was the custom in their pre-Catholic culture). As the rising chief was both baptized into the Christian faith and was already married Friar Pedro forbade this marriage. It was a bold stand. But the friar rightly knew that either all of these newly baptized Catholics should follow the essential rules of the Church (especially relating to the Sacraments) or the

fragile Catholic unity in the community would fall apart. There are no exemptions from the essential Catholic rules. (Recently you may have heard of a group called The Society of St. Pius X being "excommunicated" from the Church due to breaking a few of the major rules of the Church. In the Catholic Church, we cannot "make our own rules" that conflict with the Church.) So, Friar Pedro and the other friars took a stand for the orthodox teaching of the Catholic Church on the Sacrament of Marriage.

The rising chief was furious. One by one, he tracked down all the area Franciscan friars and brutally ended their lives. One friar survived a kidnapping and his release was secured by the governor of the St. Augustine mission (the oldest continuously occupied city in America!) This friar refused to testify against his Guale abductors and the murderers (he wanted to save their lives). But he would tell the story that was never forgotten.

Pope Francis, shortly before he died, signed off on a decree from the Dicastery for the Canonization of Saints to officially recognize the martyrdom of the Georgia Friars for they were "murdered for the faith".

For generations and from coast to coast we've had many brave Catholic men and women in America and even Catholic martyrs! As we continue to celebrate our nation's 250<sup>th</sup> also remember the Catholics who spiritually shaped this land! —Fr. George Mahas—
