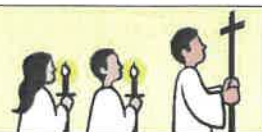

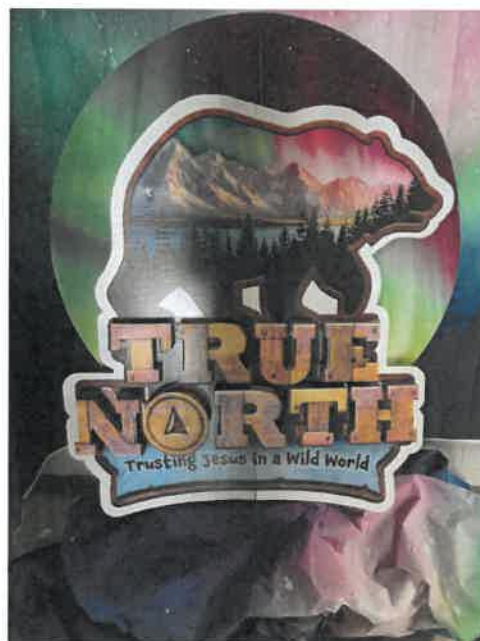

## Sixteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Hello Friends,

Vacation Bible School begins this week! When we ask the children about it they always smile and say that they are looking forward to it! This program inspires children to love their faith. It also lets them know that the entire campus at Immaculate Conception is their spiritual and community home. Why is this important? When people make memories at a parish their personal connection and investment to the parish will be lasting. This experience is made possible by our VBS leaders. We are deeply grateful for all of the wonderful leaders of VBS. They are special people. These spirit-filled women and men go above and beyond to make it the best spiritual and social week of the Summer for the children!

And we are grateful to everyone, every parishioner and patron, whether you have children in the program or not, for supporting VBS. As we have come to know the annual VBS mission has expanded into something more ambitious than the standard summer program and your help makes all the difference!

The past two years VBS raised money to make an immediate and long-lasting impact on the campus and in the church. It's historic! In 2023, they raised money for a beautiful Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary (Our Lady of Victory) shrine between the church and the rectory. I particularly appreciate the inspiring site of Mary overlooking every Ottoville Park activity that takes place 24/7 (she also has her eyes and blessings upon the school on the other side of the Little Auglaize River!) And last year the students did something that I don't recall ever being done before in our diocese: they financed the purchase of a much-needed new chalice for Immaculate Conception! It is a first rate, top-tier, hand-crafted (from Spain) sacred chalice with Latin inscriptions and images of the Evangelists and the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It is a chalice worthy of such a beautiful and inspiring church.

This year the students are pursuing a project to finance and build a new memorial and shrine to a soon-to-be canonized saint, the first millennial saint, Blessed Carlo Acutis. On September 7<sup>th</sup>, Pope Leo XIV will canonize both Blessed Carlo and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. As most of us know, Blessed Carlo was always a good child who loved his family and friends and he loved to play video games and soccer. And he had a special spiritual gift that would change and inspire many lives. His gift was faith.



More than anything, Carlo loved Jesus. His love for Jesus was manifested through service and kindness and a rare devotion to the Eucharist. Blessed Carlo was like St. John the Evangelist; he could hear the Lord's heartbeat and feel his presence. Carlo could feel it through the Eucharist. He became a young evangelist and teacher. As an evangelist, he never made people feel "ignorant" of the mysteries they did not know; he was understanding and patient. He shared through his websites all that he knew and researched to be true about the Eucharist. As most of us know Carlo, like many of us, was not spared of affliction. Sick with leukemia, he died before reaching the age of 16. Yet, as his mother quickly found out "he lives forever" in the company of saints. Carlo is someone who understands the great things in life and the great things in Heaven. He was an inspiring example, an example that particularly resonates with the millennial generation and all of us, that whatever gift God has given you, share it, go out and make a difference.

We are excited for this week! Please pray for everyone at VBS and we pray for the success of the VBS Blessed Carlo campus project! –Fr. George Mahas—

Carlo Acutis (May 3, 1991 – October 12, 2006) was a young Italian Catholic who was beatified in 2020, by Pope Francis and is in the process of canonization, set for September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025. He is known for his deep love of the Eucharist and his use of technology to spread the Gospel.

This Saint may have some things to teach his companions in Heaven- with hobbies like Pokémon, Nintendo, soccer, Spider-Man, and computer programming.

His canonization is due to the heroic virtue he demonstrated during his life, his devotion to Christ as shown to the Blessed Sacrament, and the holiness exhibited during the suffering of his final days.
