

Twenty-Fifth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Hello Friends,

While it may take some time before Pope Leo XIV makes a visit to the United States, we can see how connected he still is (and always will be) to his home country. Recently, while celebrating his 70th Birthday (Pope Leo is a young pope by recent standards!), he also made some headlines after completing his first one-on-one sit-down interview/s. The journalist he spoke with is an American, Elise Ann Allen. She completed the first authorized biography of Pope Leo, called *Leo XIV*: Citizen of the World, Missionary of the XXI Century. (The book was published first in Spanish, in Pope Leo's adopted home of Peru. It has since been published, this week, throughout the world.) Pope Leo's decision to collaborate with Elise Allen is in itself significant.

Elise Allen and her husband, the longtime Vatican reporter John Allen (who has been battling aggressive



stomach cancer during this past year) were publicly attacked in American Catholic media circles several years ago in what John Allen called a "culture of contempt". Namely, John Allen was being attacked by a since dissolved independent Catholic media outlet (that infamously sought Catholic tabloid-like material) because of his divorce and his subsequent marriage to Elise. John Allen, a highly accomplished author, and perhaps America's premier Vatican journalist of the past thirty years, who to this day also collaborates with Bishop Robert Barron and the Word on Fire ministries, wrote about how it feels and how it can possibly destroy one's career and life to be personally "attacked" in the media. (His book is called Catholics and Contempt: How Catholic Media Fuels Today's Fights and What to do About it. It's about the destructive side of the culture wars. Allen advocates for Catholic media to choose to take the moral higher road.) Never mind that John Allen and his wife have good standing in the

Church (Allen's first marriage was nullified), a few popular YouTube personalities sought to destroy them. Out of all the people Pope Leo could have chosen for his first in-depth interviews, he chose Elise, of Crux Media, to spend time with him at Castel Gandolfo and the Vatican.

In the released excerpts from the interviews Pope Leo made the biggest headline for openly wondering about the justice and fairness of extreme income inequality. This is especially the case when comparing CEO incomes to worker wages. He said: "For example, CEOs that 60 years ago might have been making four to six times more than what the workers are receiving, the last figure I saw, it's 600 times more than what average workers are receiving. Yesterday the news said that Elon Musk is going to be the first trillionaire in the world. What does that mean and what's that about? If that is the only thing that has value anymore, then we're in big trouble..." Working in Peru for many years (as a missionary and as a bishop) and being from Chicago, Pope Leo has witnessed income inequality. Like the Prophet Amos from this weekend's first reading, he advocates on behalf of the poor and those who are barely getting by. The wealthy should feel a God given responsibility to help their struggling brothers and sisters.

So, an American journalist from Colorado was the first to get the papal scoops! In some ways Elise Allen is like Pope Leo XIV. She is, seemingly, an unassuming, hard-working person who is not given to self-promotion and who has been underestimated by some, but chosen, nonetheless. Pope Leo's choice to work with her says a lot about him and the direction this new "Citizen of the World" pontiff would like to lead the Church. "He is very calm" she says. Calm and cooperative and never venturing into personal attacks seems to be his way and the way he is encouraging us to follow. —Fr. George Mahas—
