ABOUT THE SHOW

Admission is a witty, heartfelt musical comedy that takes a **sharp (and hilarious)** look at the chaos of the **college admissions process**.

Beneath the humor and catchy songs lies a deeper story about the **evolving relationship between parents and their children** in today's high-pressure world. With **relatable characters** and laugh-out-loud moments, *Admission* shines a light on **ambition, anxiety, and the lengths we go to for the people we love**.

SYNOPSIS

A **determined mother** is laser-focused on securing the **perfect future** for her teenage son but he's just trying to **make it through** the day. As they **navigate the absurd world** of college admissions, they encounter everything from questionable guidance counselors to over-the-top campus tours and high-powered advisors. As the pressure builds, the **line between helping and controlling** begins to blur. How far is too far when it comes to protecting your child's future?

Admission is a **funny, fast-paced journey** through privilege, pressure, and the complicated bond between parent and child. And if you're honest... you might do the same.

SETTING & TIME

Setting: A middle-class American home, high school, & college campus

Time: Present day, Autumn

DEVELOPMENT HISTORY:

THE MUSICAL *ADMISSION*

“Admission” was inspired by stumbling across a YouTube mini-musical that satirized Millennials. Having just navigated the college decision process with our oldest child, that crazy experience seemed ripe for the picking. Parody is fun, but it soon became clear that the heart of the issue is parents and kids and why we act like we do.

After nine months of writing composer Benjamin Taylor joined the team and a week-long songwriting retreat in May of 2019, using the sanctuary at FUMC Mocksville as our studio, turned crude melodies into real songs. A table reading at UNC School of the Arts that fall coordinated by Professor Janine Hawley provided invaluable feedback and credibility. After revisions the first “final” product was ready in February 2020. Then a pandemic intervened.

Our entry into the 2022 Florida Festival of New Musicals finished in the top half of over 100 entries. The 2023 Tyler (TX) Civic Theatre New Play Festival was a breakthrough as *“Admission”* advanced to the finals, which included a limited staged reading, and ultimately finished in second place.

Competition results and feedback were encouraging, but the real goal is to see this project come to life on stage. The Davie County Arts Council came on board in the spring of 2025 and connected with director Castanya Breen who held a mini-workshop with her students in Texas prior to making the move to NC. One more revision and then layers of creativity added by the talented cast and crew over two months of rehearsals led to the final result you will see on stage today.

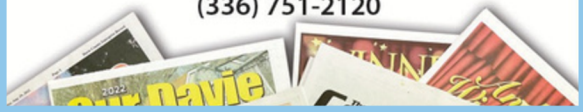
