Note Mass times change

Message from Fr. Tony Hesse:

As I am sure you all know, this past week, our world was shocked to hear the passing of our Holy Father Pope Francis. I was just coming upstairs at my parents' place when my Mom asked if I got the update. Well, to be honest, I do not get updates like that. So, no, what kind of update I asked. She told me then that the Pope died. I was shocked. I just saw him that morning before (Easter Sunday) driving around in his popemobile blessing the people. Again, it reminded me, never be too sure about life. It can change in an instant. Be ready!

Nonetheless, because of his passing, I am not sure if you noticed St. Anne church and school and St. Catherine's main doors this past week if you drove by. Inside we have our portrait of our Holy Father with a votive candle near it draped in black and then on the outside of the church we have this (what they call) "black bunting" draped over the doors of the churches and some on the front doors of the school.



Basically, black bunting is a traditional symbol of mourning and respect, used to honor the death of a loved one. In this case we are honoring and remembering our Holy Father Pope Francis and all his contributions, sacrifices, and what he has done for our Church and Her people. The black bunting is done to show reverence and acknowledge our loss. As people drive by in our communities, they can see (especially if they are not Catholic) that we are mourning a loss of someone very special to us. As well as a reminder to pray for him, his soul, and the future of our church.

To help with the prayers, the diocesan office put together prayer cards (help yourself – they are in the gathering spaces) as well as praying for him during the petitions, and then we will be praying the "Novendiales" (a novena) for him after all of the Masses as well – starting April 26 to May 4. We will also have these packets available.

Although I never met him personally, I did see him from a distance years ago when I went to Rome with my family. However, while serving as the Bishop of Fairbanks, Alaska, Bishop Chad had the honor of meeting Pope Francis in 2015, 2016 at a new bishop's course, and in 2020 at an "Ad limina" visit. He was most gracious and kind and quite fascinated with Alaska. And some of you recall about 10 years ago Leo Prokosch (a parishioner) was kissed by him as an infant. How cool is that!

Our Church experienced a lot of blessings and challenges during his pontificate. We are grateful for what he has done and now we pray that he rest in the peace of Christ and that our Lord's Perpetual Light will forever shine upon him.

As we pray that our Holy Father is now experiencing our Lord in all His glory, let us also keep our First Communicants in our prayers as well. We will be celebrating First Holy Communion the next couple of Sundays in our AFC. May they experience our Lord (not in heaven but of heaven) in the Holy

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter this solemn period of mourning and prayer for our late Holy Father Pope Francis, we are called to unite in supplication for the repose of his soul, that he might swiftly come to his eternal reward with the Father in Heaven.

With profound reverence, the Diocese of New Ulm invites all the faithful to attend a Memorial Mass for Pope Francis at the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity in New Ulm on Friday, May 2, at 11:00 a.m. Priests of the diocese are encouraged to concelebrate if they are able (a Chasuble and Stole will be provided).

Even as we mourn the death of the Holy Father, we are strengthened by the hope of the Easter season. The promise of the Resurrection illuminates our path forward, reminding us that death has been conquered through Christ our Lord.

Following the Mass, a light reception will be held in Leifeld Hall.

May the soul of the Holy Father, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

PRIESTS should also review the attached document, which outlines the Liturgical Norms that are to be observed throughout this period of Mourning. More Information will be communicated as it is made available by the Vatican and the USCCB. Also, attached to this upcoming week's UPDATE, you will find additional resources such as a Memorial Prayer Card to be made available to the faithful, as well as the Finalized "Novendiales" which we are asked to pray after all parish Masses from Saturday, April 26, through Sunday, May 4.

Also attached is a document "Interregnum," that has interesting information about what happens in the period between popes.


