And finally, with the idea of Holy Communion, we are in need of people to help bring Communion to the homebound, nursing homes, and the hospital, as well as those who can help share our Lord during Mass. As I wrote a few weeks ago, if you are interested in being commissioned with this ministry, and/or, assisting with exposing and reposing our Lord in Adoration, please let me know, so that I can get your name(s) to the Bishop. This is a beautiful and humbling ministry. Please pray and discern if God is calling you to it.
